



## Dress Code

### Uniform

- Black Bistro Style uniform.
- Black long sleeve button up dress shirt
- Long solid black tie (tie clasped may be worn to keep from dangling)
- Black pants. Dickies or dress pants are fine. \*\* No Jeans \*\*
- Black NON SLIP dress shoes. NO Skate or Tennis Shoes
- \*\*Wine Opener, bottle opener and Lighter\*\*
- Long Black Bistro Apron. This will be provided for you by NorCal Event Staffing.
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### Jewelry

Jewelry should be discrete and professional in appearance. Ear piercings are acceptable, provided the jewelry is of a conservative and professional nature, such as studs and sleepers. In order to maintain a safe workplace, wearing facial piercings other than in ears is not permitted (i.e. nose rings, eyebrow rings, tongue, etc.)

### Hair

Hair should be worn in a neat and tidy fashion and be of a discrete and professional color and style. If Occupational Health and Safety rules require it, long hair should be worn tied back.

### Tattoos

Tattoos, that could be perceived to be offensive, should be discretely covered (e.g. tattoos of naked men/women, skulls or daggers dripping blood, etc.)

### National Garments

National costume and garments worn to comply with religious requirements are acceptable as long as they do not pose an Occupational Health and Safety risk and are neat and modest.

### Pregnant Employees

Pregnant employees are expected to adhere to the company dress standards.

### Responsibilities

treat the uniform with care.

- Wear the uniform at all times during work hours.
- Ensure that the uniform is kept clean and presentable at all times. Shirts should always be neat and ironed.
- Ensure the uniform is replaced if it becomes faded, ripped or torn.
