The National Restaurant Association's ServSafe® California Food Handler Online Course and Assessment is approved to meet ALL requirements (both course and test) to receive your California Food Handler

All food handlers (part-time, full-time or temporary) must obtain a California Food Handler Card. New hires have 30 days after the date of hire.

To receive your California Food Handler card:

- You must complete a course and take a test and pass with a score of 70 percent or higher.
- Download your Certificate of Achievement and California Food Handler Card upon passing the test.

To Purchase a Course

- 1. Go to www.FoodHandlerUSA.com and enter your zip code
- 2. Select "ServSafe Food Handler Online Course & Assessment" and click "Add to Shopping Cart"
- 3. Click "Create New Profile" if you are a new customer and complete user registration form
- 4. Enter "CADIST10" in coupon code box and click "Apply Coupon" to receive your 10% discount
- 5. Click "Go to Checkout" and enter your credit card payment
