October 2024 was our busiest month EVER! **421** individuals visited the food pantry, feeding a total of  
**282 Children**  
**444 Adults,**  
**& 182 Seniors**



In 2024, we assisted **1144** different individuals. These folks fed their household members:  
**752 Children,**  
**1231 Adults,**  
**& 489 Seniors**

Our 2025 budget is  
**\$256,475.**

Over **79%** of our budget goes directly towards programming.

The cost of food every three weeks is **\$3000** to support a growing number of shoppers. We now see over **400 shoppers** every month!



An average of **4,000 pounds of food** leave our doors every month to enter Dorchester County homes. Each client is welcome to visit once a month for supplemental groceries.
