



WESTLAKES ARCHERS are excited to host the 2025 ASNSW State Field Championships

This is a two-day World Archery Arrowhead registered event where archers will be able to claim World Archery Field awards.

A 24 Target Marked World Archery Field will be shot on both days. Scores will be combined for the two days.

Dates: 31 May and 1 June 2025

VENUE: Westlakes Archers, [Fassifern Oval, 51 Miller Road, Fassifern, 2283](#)

The deadline for online registration is 11.59pm on Friday 16th MAY 2025

No Late Entries will be accepted.

Divisions: All bow type and age categories will be catered for as per the AA and WA rules

Pegs: As per the relevant AA rules (red, blue and yellow)

Entry fees: Both days: Seniors \$70 and Juniors \$50. One day: \$40 each.

PROGRAM:

Registration from 7.30 am each day

Equipment inspection from 8.00 am each day

Practice from 8.30 am each day

Muster 9.30 am

Shooting 10 am start on both days

NOTE - We reserve the right to change the shooting program based upon entry numbers, any changes to the program will be sent to competitors by email following the close of entries

SCORING:

- Scoring will be undertaken using a paper scorecard (one per archer) and an electronic device (one per target) using Archers Diary, a competitor from each target must provide an electronic device for scoring.
- Each archer must be registered and listed in Archers Diary.
- If an archer is not listed in Archers Diary their entry will not be accepted until such time as the archer's club registers the competitor in Archers Diary. It is not the responsibility of the tournament organiser or ANSW to register an archer in Archery Diary.
- If an archer is not registered in Archers Diary the host will send the archer a reminder email and it will be archers' responsibility to ensure their club registers them into Archers Diary by 11.59pm, 24 May 2025

Medals presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division

COMMUNICATIONS:

Dress Regulations:

The Organising Committee will be enforcing Archery Australia Rules (7.10) in respect of athlete's dress. No camouflage clothing is to be worn whilst shooting.

Note: No dogs are permitted on the grounds, on Council advice, only in the car park on a lead and under the control of a responsible adult at all times.

Scoring will be both paper and live using Archers Diary.
