The Career Transition Specialist will be responsible for traveling throughout the greater New York City area working in local high schools providing career and personal development workshops. This part-time role will be 20 hours per week at \$25 per hour. A flexible schedule, consisting of a hybrid work environment, from home and or in the community.

- · Collaborate on the creation of career & personal development workshops for youth.
- Co-facilitate weekly youth career & personal development in-person workshops at local middle & high schools in the NYC area.
- Develop internship partnerships for youth.

- Co-manage a caseload of students who attend various high schools and assist in their transition process.
- Maintain a high level of customer service satisfaction in the relationship with school-based personnel.

- Currently enrolled in a graduate school vocational rehabilitation program, mental health, or school counseling program.
- Ability to create your own graduate school practicum/internship experience.
- Knowledge of New York City High Schools.
- Some work experience and education in the human services industry or working with people with disabilities.
- · Interest in having a career in working with young adults with disabilities.
- · Strong interpersonal skills, and ability to engage young adults, the community, and businesses.
