Forklift – Daily Inspection

- ✓ Forklifts should be inspected by the operator before each shift.
- ✓ The daily forklift inspection should include checks to ensure that:
 - 1. The overhead guard is in place.
 - 2. The hydraulic cylinders are in good shape and functioning properly.
 - 3. The mast assembly is in good condition.
 - 4. The lift chains and rollers are in good condition.
 - 5. The forks are in good condition and operate properly.
 - 6. The tires are in good condition and properly inflated.
 - 7. Fluids are at the correct levels.
 - 8. The gauges are operating properly.
 - 9. The vehicle steers properly.
 - 10. The brakes are in good condition and functioning.
 - 11. The front tail, and brake lights are functioning.
 - 12. The horn, seatbelts, and other safety systems are functioning properly.
- ✓ Walk through an inspection using the listed requirements and the inspection points mandated in the vehicle operator manual.
