

Services for Children

The table below identifies services available to children through the Medically Fragile Waiver, Supports Waiver, Mi Via Waiver, Developmental Disabilities Waiver, State General Funds and Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment programs.

Note: Waiver services must not duplicate services offered under the Medicaid Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment (EPSDT) benefit, Medicaid School-Based Services, services offered by the New Mexico Public Education Department, the State Vocational Rehabilitation Agency, or services offered through the Early Childhood Education and Care Department.

Note: A child is defined as a person under the age of 18 years old. However, for the purpose of EPSDT and Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) eligibility, a "child" is defined as a person supported by these services under the age of 21 years old.
