- Fingerprint Release Form.

 Ensure all documents (application form, FEMA certificates, and Fingerprint Release Form) are submitted together to MVFDHR@clarkcountynv.gov

## 3. Onboarding Process

If your application is accepted, you will go through the following onboarding steps:

- 1. Background Check:
  - A comprehensive background check will be conducted.
- 2. Physical Examination:
  - A two-part physical examination to ensure you meet the physical demands of the role.
- 3. Online Training:
  - Complete any additional online training modules as required.
- 4. Orientation:
  - Attend an orientation session to understand the district's operations and your role.

# 4. Ongoing Requirements

As a member of the Moapa Valley Fire District, you are required to:

- 24 Hours On-Call Per Month:
  - Be available for on-call duties for a minimum of 24 hours each month.
- Attend Trainings:
  - Participate in trainings, which may occur up to twice a month. Attendance is essential for maintaining skills and knowledge.
