

# How to Apply to Become a Firefighter with

## Moapa Valley Fire District

Thank you for your interest in joining the Moapa Valley Fire District. Please follow these steps to complete your application and ensure it is considered:

### 1. Complete Required FEMA Classes

- Download and Review the FEMA Class Instructions PDF

### 2. Submit Your Application

#### Required Documents:

- Completed Moapa Valley Fire District application form.
- Certificates of completion for FEMA ICS 100, 200, 700 (as detailed in the PDF instructions).
- Fingerprint Release Form.

#### Submission Instructions:

- Ensure all documents (application form, FEMA certificates, and Fingerprint Release Form) are submitted together to [MVFDHR@clarkcountynv.gov](mailto:MVFDHR@clarkcountynv.gov)

**\*\*\*Incomplete applications will not be accepted\*\*\***

### 3. Onboarding Process

If your application is accepted, you will go through the following onboarding steps:

1. **Background Check:**
  - A comprehensive background check will be conducted.
2. **Physical Examination:**
  - A two-part physical examination to ensure you meet the physical demands of the role.
3. **Online Training:**
  - Complete any additional online training modules as required.
4. **Orientation:**
  - Attend an orientation session to understand the district's operations and your role.

### 4. Ongoing Requirements

As a member of the Moapa Valley Fire District, you are required to:

- **24 Hours On-Call Per Month:**
  - Be available for on-call duties for a minimum of 24 hours each month.
- **Attend Trainings:**
  - Participate in trainings, which may occur up to twice a month. Attendance is essential for maintaining skills and knowledge.
