A. Chief Stephen Neel

- We are currently finalizing an application for another AFG grant to fund an exhaust removal system for all stations, as well as washers and dryers for turnouts.
- The new rescue vehicle has been inspected, delivered to Station 74, and equipped with an auto-load gurney. We are awaiting the installation of a new radio system before putting it into service.
- We are onboarding 16 new volunteers, bringing our total close to 90.
- Wildland training is progressing well. This year, we plan to deploy a rescue unit, two tenders, and a Rapid Extrication Module Support (REMS) team.
- We are also awaiting the arrival of new radio consolettes.
- The new Assistant Chief, Brian Young, is almost ready to operate independently.
- NV Energy has been resisting the implementation of fire mitigation measures for the lithium battery storage area at the Reid Gardner site. We are currently negotiating a development agreement to acquire a ladder truck for enhanced fire response.

- An upgrade is in the works for electronic Patient Care Reports (ePCR)
