Instructions for Completing FEMA Classes to Apply for

Moapa Valley Fire District

Thank you for your interest in joining the Moapa Valley Fire District! To be considered for a firefighter position, you must complete the following FEMA online courses and include the certificates of completion with your application: ICS 100, ICS 200, and ICS 700. Please follow the instructions below to complete these courses and submit your application properly.

Step 1: Create a FEMA Student Identification (SID) Number

- Visit the FEMA SID Registration Website: Go to the FEMA SID Registration page - https://cdp.dhs.gov/femasid/register
- 2. **Register for an SID**: Follow the prompts to create a new FEMA SID if you don't already have one. This number will be used to track your training and certificates.

Step 2: Complete FEMA Online Courses

- 1. Access the FEMA Independent Study Program:
- Visit the FEMA Emergency Management Institute (EMI) website.
- Under "Independent Study" click on "IS Course List" to browse the list of available courses.
- 2. Enroll in and Complete the Required Courses:
- ICS 100 Introduction to the Incident Command System: Search for "IS-100.C" and complete the course.
- ICS 200 Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response:
 Search for "IS-200.C" and complete the course.

- ICS 700 An Introduction to the National Incident Management System: Search for "IS-700.B" and complete the course.
- Note: Each course will involve watching instructional videos and completing a quiz at the end. Ensure you pass each quiz to receive your certificate.

3. Download Your Certificates:

- After completing each course, log in to your FEMA EMI account.
- Navigate to the "My Learning" section to find and download your certificates of completion.

Step 3: Prepare Your Application

1. Gather Your Certificates:

 Ensure you have the certificates for ICS 100, ICS 200, and ICS 700 saved as PDF files or images.

2. Complete the Application Form:

 Download and fill out the Moapa Valley Fire District application form and Background Release form. You can obtain these forms from our website or office.

3. Attach Your Certificates:

 Include all four FEMA course certificates with your application. Ensure that each certificate is clearly visible and legible.

4. Submit Your Application:

 Submit your completed application form and FEMA certificates according to the submission instructions provided on our website or by contacting our office.
