VI. COMMENTS BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC

A. Randy Richins from Logandale, NV, "I am Randy Richins, I have had the opportunity to work with Chief Neel on a couple of projects and I just wanted to do a quick report. The first one for Emergency Management was the GMRS project through the preparedness fair that we had. We had designated channel 16. I have not been able to get my tower up, however, even better, we have an active repeater on channel 24. That is the same frequency as channel 16. From anywhere, we can use a little portable and we can get the information out to anyone in Logandale and Overton using less than five watts. It will also reach Glendale quite successfully. Lytle Ranch is in an RF shadow so we are working on ways to fix that but do not currently have a solution. Excellent coverage through Logandale to I-15, and through Overton past Robins Nest. We have had weekly nets on Sunday at 1915. If you would like to join us and are GMRS certified through the FCC that is fine. The Moapa Valley Fire District applied for Low Power FM (LPFM) in December of 2023 through Emergency Management. It was received and approved. It is channel 101.1 and is not currently on the air. We have one year from our grant date in March 2024 to construct it. We had a potential powersite that was not successful so modifications will be made through the FCC for a new site. The tower that will be used and upgraded is currently located at MVFD Station 73 in Logandale. VHF testing will be done, which won't be the same frequency but will be close enough to mirror propagation."

 Recruitment and Retention numbers are 70 current volunteers and 29 in the onboarding process. Currently are no longer accepting new applications. New inquiries will be placed on a waiting list.
