A \$5 late fee will be charged for all entries received after the deadline. This includes all phone entries. Phone entries must be confirmed by Twayne or Tom. The Junior/Veteran/Centurion or Blind Draw Doubloes division can be vour third division. Play in the Junior/Veteran division may begin Sunday afternoon.

This years tournament will feature a Junior multi-bounce Team Challenge that will test your skills in the court and on the bowling lanes. Pizza, pop and big fun are on the menu, you won't want to miss this. Beginner players are welcome, no tournament experience needed. The Junior cost will be \$15.

RULES AND REFEREES

Single elimination format with matches consisting of two games to fifteen and a tie-breaker to eleven. USA Racquetball rules apply including mandatory USA Racquetball-approved lensed eyeguards.

Penn HD purple balls will be used for all matches. Referees will not be used. All players will use the honor system.
