All other qualifiers for Nationals have been eliminated (such as Masters and Senior/Masters Tournaments) in an effort to maximize participation in the Adult Regionals and to promote the event. Your choices for alternate sites if you plan to attend Nationals are: Chicago (April 18-21), St. Louis (March 15-17), and Lincoln (April). The AARA may reconsider a Minnesota Regional at some future date. If it is important to you as a player to have a Regional in our area, call us with suggestions about how to increase attendance or help solicit sponsors so the event can be successful.

Enjoy the rest of the great summer weather. I hope to see most of you at State Doubles in November.

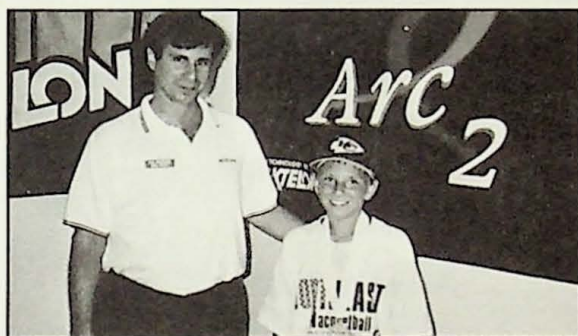

Racquetball Tip: Tournament Confidence

There are lots of things that players can do to shore up their confidence before a tough tournament match. Some of the things I do are:

1. **Stretch** every muscle I can. If possible, I even hang on a railing with my racquetball arm to stretch my whole side. By Sunday, I'm usually pretty sore, so it could mean the difference between winning and losing.

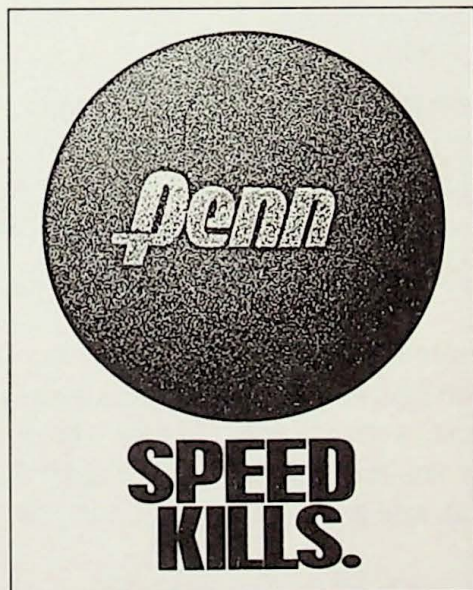
2. **Ride** an AerobiCycle or get on a treadmill for at least five minutes. Getting my heart pumping a little helps me get moving faster/earlier on the court.



3. **Hit** every shot well at least twice. I try to get the bad shots out of the way early and then remember the good ones.

4. Open up a brand **new glove**. I know my racquet won't slip in my hand and I have the confidence to go for shots when the pressure is on.

You probably have more confidence-boosters that you rely on, as well. We'd love to have you share them with us in a future issue of *Minnesota Racquetball*.

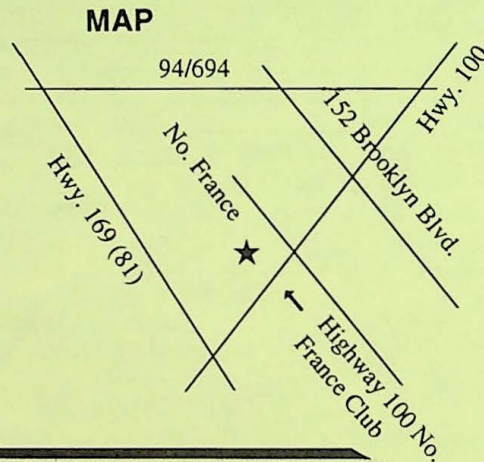

SPECIAL TOURNAMENT NOTES

1. Lockers are limited and cost \$.25 per use, so prepare accordingly. Valuables may be checked at the activities desk.

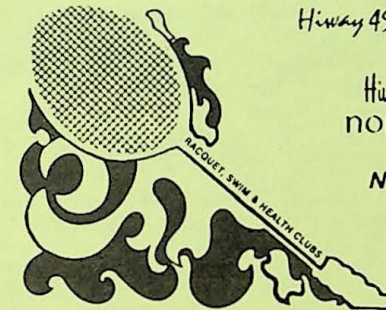

PRIZES

ELIGIBILITY

You must live, work or be a full-time student in Minnesota and compete in no other state championships. This is an MSRA/AARA sanctioned event. All participants must hold a current MSRA/AARA competitive license or purchase one on site for an annual \$20 fee (Jr. \$15 w/magazine, \$10 without). Competitive licenses must be current before you play a match. AARA rules apply including "**lensed eyewear designed for racquet sports is mandatory.**" ***This includes prescription eyewear.

CLASSIFICATION

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reclassify any entrant because of their tournament experience or playing level. Doubles teams must play to the level of the highest skilled player.

STARTING TIMES

All Metro players should be prepared to play at 3:00 p.m. on Friday. Out of town players should be prepared to play at 6:00 p.m. on Friday. Court Sports Ranking System

Players begin with a default ranking when entering a new age or skill division. Every match played in an **MSRA sanctioned** tournament counts toward your ranking. For example: if you win in two games (15-5, 15-9), you have outscored your opponent by 16 points. If your opponent was ranked higher than you (an upset), your ranking goes up by 16 points and your opponent's goes down by 16. If your opponent is ranked lower than you, the difference in scores is split evenly: you go up by half and your opponent goes down by half. Scores for the lower ranked player are handicapped by one point for every 20 points difference in ranking, and are included in the lower ranked player's scores before the match result points are

awarded by the system which affect your ranking.

The system is based on your ability to score points against a wide variety of opponents. Ranking printouts include your name, your "Rank Change" (how many cumulative points you have earned since September 1 of the current season), and your current ranking.

The Court Sports Ranking System program may be purchased on floppy disk for IBM compatible computers. Any club, YMCA, or individual interested in providing a ranking system for their players may call CSRS at (507) 753-2051.

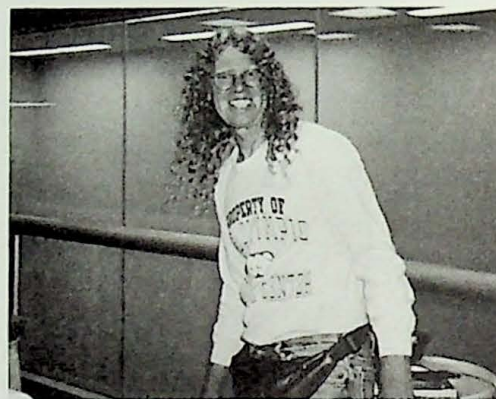
