
Huczek featured in Sports Illustrated

Jack Huczek was featured in the February 2, 1998 issue of Sports Illustrated

The "Faces in the Crowd" section highlighted Jack's recent win at the World Junior Racquetball Championships held in Fountain Valley California this past December

This is the sixth consecutive World Title for Jack who beat Matthew McElhiney of Bradenton, Florida, 15-5, 15-4 in the 14 & under singles His victory helped the United States win its second straight World Junior Title

Jack, age 15, is the youngest member of the Junior National team and was voted Most Valuable Player based on athletic achievement, team attitude and leadership The team also pre-

sented him with the 1st place team trophy to honor him as MVP.

Jack also captured second place in the 16 & under doubles by teaming with Scott Foster of California. The team beat James Ford and Ryan Staten.
