## Referees Clinic

The Michigan Racquetball Association, in an attempt to upgrade the level of refereeing, sponsored Michigan's first referees' clinic at the Franklin Racquet Club in Southfield on October 4. Jim Easterling, head pro and racquetball director at Franklin, and APRO member, and Phil Klintworth, head pro at the Michigan Racquetball and Fitness Club in Lansing, and APRO head in Michigan, conducted the clinic. The session included a thorough explanation of USRA rules; a brief written test; an extended question and answer period; the proper use of linesmen; and how to control a match. Numerous court demonstrations were given, such as court hinders, avoidable hinders and technical fouls.

Participants were encouraged to ask questions and the thirty-eight racquetball players who attended the session, ranging in age from 16 through 57, left with a much keener understanding of the game and a better appreciation of how to referee. ## Rating System Changes

Beginning February 1, the point system will be realigned in the men's divisions only, with the exception of the age and junior divisions. The new numbers are:

In addition, tournament finalists in all men's and women's divisions must move up to the next higher class. When moving up a class, the winner receives the minimum number of points for that division, plus 16, and the second place finisher the minimum, plus 8. Both these changes will eliminate a great deal of class jumping from tournament to tournament. Also, by lowering the points required in a class, a player moving to a higher class for the first time won't be seeded without ever having played in that class.

The first two MRA tournaments illustrate that we're in for some exciting racquetball this season. All divisions are producing close, exciting matches from the opening rounds to the finals, each with its share of upsets. In the Men's Open, Flint's Bob Wilhelm, the tournament's top seed, and one of last year's dominant players, was again upset in the first round of play, this time by Craig Rylee.
