But on March 1 through 5, the University of Minnesota hosted an open house where all interested parties were invited to tour and use the new Recreational Sports Facility on the east campus. Several MSRA representatives gave exhibition matches and generated quite a lot of interest from students and faculty.

Thursday night was a special celebrity event. Three "famous" women players (Dana Sibell, Tina Lamb and Carol Kriegler) and five local celebrities (including Leo Lewis, Dan Endy and Larry Fitzgerald of K-FAN) were divided into two teams of four. A round robin tournament tournament with everyone playing one game to 15 determined the winner in each team. These two players, Dana Sibell from Team 1 and Tina Lamb from Team 2, played in the final game, with Dana defeating Tina.

Right behind the Radisson University and the Harvard Street Ramp, the new facilities are most impressive. Two of the courts have everything they need to host competitive racquetball, complete with a built-in refereeing mike system and side and back glass wall viewing.

Board elections are coming up at the State Tournament. Please take time to cast a ballot. We seem to have a fair amount of interest in the positions up for election. We need Board members who are willing to spend time outside meetings on committee assignments. Well-known racquetball players are not necessarily the best Board members, so if you are a hard worker, please let Nancy Bennett know that you want to run. Nancy will recommend the slate of candidates for election. Anyone not on the ballot who wishes to run for election will need to stage a write-in campaign at the tournament. Exercise your right to have a voice in the organization.

Another election is coming up, too. The AARA Board election. This is a mail in ballot which will come in your Racquetball Magazine. If you bring these ballots to the State Tournament, we will mail them in mass to the AARA. We really want you to cast a ballot in the national election. The AARA is the national governing body for the sport of racquetball, and provides the directional focus for the sport. Our own Marta Groess, former MSRA president, is running for national office. Your support for her candidacy will allow us a more direct link to national policy. Marta is a great person, and a good negotiator. She is knowledgeable about financial matters, and will help the AARA Board keep spending priorities in line with income. If every Minnesota member voted for Marta for the AARA Board, she would probably be elected. Other qualified individuals are also running: Margo Daniels (National Tournament Commissioner), Dario Mas (Delaware President and Masters Council), and Janell Marriot (former pro tour player and Rhode Island Board member). You may vote for three people.

Mark your calendars for the return of Men's Professional Racquetball to Minnesota: June 23 through 27. The next newsletter will have entry forms for the Pro-Am Tournament, open to everyone which will run concurrently, and ticket order forms for the Pro matches. The event will be televised on ESPN, and is sponsored by Volkswagen Credit International and the International Racquetball Tour. There are sure to be some great matches, and we'll have lots of out-of-town participants. If you'd like to help the local organizing committee, leave a message at the office (612) 920-6652.

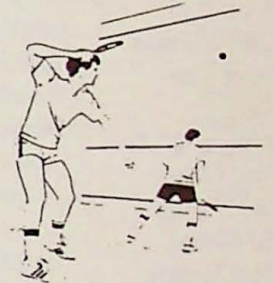

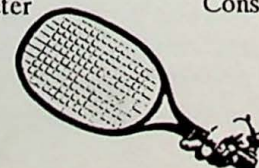
