Ektelon kicks-off championship series

Ektelon, the dominant name in racquetball, and Molly O'Brien, one of the top tournament promoters in the East, have joined forces to create the new Ektelon Championship Racquetball Series for the 1993-94 season. The kickoff tourney is planned October 29-31 at the King George Racquetball Club in Greenbrook, New Jersey Other tournaments are scheduled at clubs in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware and Maryland

"We're really excited about doing this series of tournaments," said O'Brien, who has played racquetball for 12 years and been a member of Team Ektelon for nearly that long. "I think where the most racquetball competition is lacking is in providing championshipquality events. All the tournaments seem the same, with nothing to distinguish them. But working together with Ektelon, we have developed a premiere circuit of racquetball tournaments that offers more to men and women of all playing levels."

Ektelon approached O'Brien to develop the tournament series because of her reputation as an outstanding event and tournament promoter. Her primary focus has been on Women's Professional Rac-

quetball Association (WPRA) — she's currently ranked seventh among the nation's professional women players, and has successfully arranged and coordinated pro stops, clinics and other events for WPRA for many years.

"There was a definite need for something better than the average racquetball tournament to attract grassroots players, " noted Ektelon player promotions manager Teni Graham. "We have a tremendous amount of respect for Molly as a tournament promoter, and know this championship series will be successful in her hands," Graham added.

A unique aspect of the championship series is the Ektelon Bonus Pool. "No

other tournament series offers this type of point program incentives," O'Brien explained. For participating in each tournament, players receive 20 points per division entered. Winners add 30 points, finalists add 20 points and semifinalists add 10 points. O'Brien will post everyone's current point standing at each event to spark interest. Prizes including Ektelon t-shirts gloves, warmups, shoes and even new Ektelon RTS series racguets. The man and woman who receive the most Ektelon bonus points will each win a grand prize for travel in the U.S.
