On Sunday, March 5, Lori Kaiser received the The 1995 ISRA Distinguished Service Award, presented annually since 1978, by the Illinois State Racquetball Association. The award is given to an individual who has brought extraordinary commitment and respected leadership to amateur racquetball in Illinois. Nominations are sought from the ISRA membership, and the winner is selected through secret ballot by the current ISRA Governing Board of Directors.

Lori has served in a variety of important positions during the past eight years. She is currently the ISRA Treasurer and Membership Chairperson, and co-administers the ISRA Chicagoland Travel League, which involves over twenty clubs and 150 racquetball players.

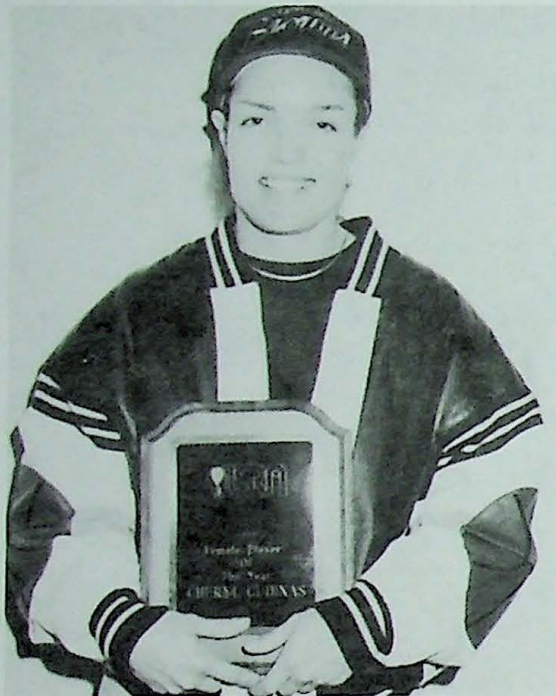

# GREG HASTY AND CHERYL GUDINAS 1994 PLAYERS OF THE YEAR ALEX SPAETH - MOST IMPROVED

On Sunday, March 5, Greg Hasty and Cheryl Gudinas received the 1994 ISRA Male & Female Players of The Year Awards. Congratulations to both players for their achievements in 1994.

**Greg Hasty, Sr.** compiled an enviable record during 1994, either winning or taking second in a tournament in every month of the year, except the slack season, June, July and August. First place wins included Revie Sorey Classic, Woodfield St. Valentine's Day, Shamrock Shootout, Negrete Open, Peoria No Frills, Illinois Masters, Saluki Open, Glass Court Turkey Shoot, (A's and 45+), State Doubles, and Cardiac Classic. He is currently ranked second, nationally in the Men's 45+.

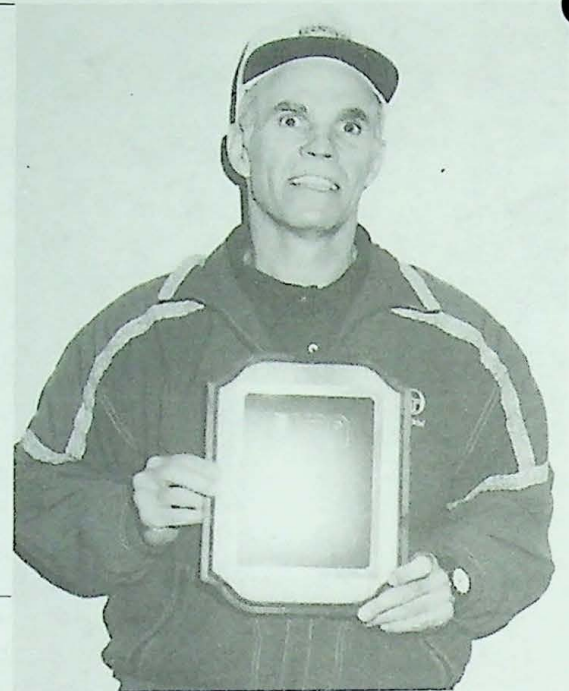


Cheryl Gudinas

Cheryl Gudinas, the first three-time winner, continued her rapidly ascending racquetball career during 1994. Her pro ranking jumped to #4 from #14, after finishing in her first finals at the November 1994 WPRA tournament. Cheryl finished third at the AARA National in her age division, qualifying again for the U.S. National Team. She was a Pan Am Trials gold medalist in Argentina in March, 1994, and is a defending, two time Olympic Festival Champion. Cheryl won (with Kim Russell) the National Doubles Women's 25+.

# RANKING SYSTEM A SUCCESS

In the spring of 1994, the ISRA decided to implement the WRSA computer ranking system. The program awards a number rating for each player in each division (singles, doubles and mixed doubles). A player's rating changes with every match result entered, and is based upon the rating difference between players in each match, and the actual match score. Special, consistent procedures handle forfeits, injury withdrawals, etc.

The system is dependent upon accurate and timely reporting of results by tournament directors. Data must be entered by ISRA almost immediately following a tournament, so fresh rankings are available for the next event.

The player feed-back we have received tells us that the results have been well worth the effort. The system has created an almost totally objective seeding tool for tournament directors, and has improved the quality of matches for players. It is now far more likely that the top four in each division will meet in the semi finals, and that early matches for all divisions are accurately and fairly seeded.

The ISRA sends a sincere THANK YOU to each of this year's sanctioned tournament directors whose co-operation made our ranking system a reality.
