## Rules Are Not Red Tape

When we play the same opponents every week the rule book is often tossed aside since everyone knows one another and has a familiar "understanding" of how to play the game. In a big league match there may be a few disagreements, but in the end you are able to settle them - if only because you see each other the following week! Then comes THE TOURNAMENT: different people from different places.

Rules are the universal language of the court. Without them, chaos and bullies reign.

The primary responsibility of a referee is to protect the interests of the players in a fast paced game. For example, the referee should not be shy about enforcing the 30 second time-out. Is it fair to allow one player more time when his or her opponent is

The MSRA has established an annual scholarship program. The MSRA will award one \$150 scholarship every year. The scholarship will be awarded on the following criteria;

1. *Scholastic (1/3)*
  - a. *GPA*
  - b. *Extracurricular activities*
  - c. *Special awards*
2. *Racquetball (1/3)*
  - a. *Frequency of tournament participation*
3. *Attitude (1/3)*
  - a. *On and off-court behavior*
  - b. *Community service*
- b. *Playing ability*
- c. *Awards and achievements*

The scholarship will be awarded to a full-time, under-graduate student at a two or four year accredited institution. The student must be a member of MSRA and be a resident of Minnesota. The student can either be a high school senior, or a freshman, sophomore, or junior in college. The purpose of the scholarship is to help with tuition; as such, the scholarship will be paid directly to the college.

The MSRA wants to create a scholarship for racquetball because we believe that good racquetball promotes good citizenship by teaching virtue and character. Scholastic education should dovetail with on-court education in building character, along with the other benefits of racquetball such as fun, good health, socializing, and psychological benefits.

## Metro Clinics Continue Monthly-Almost

As outlined in the last MSRA newsletter, clinics for the Junior Players (remember that "juniors" are 18 years old or younger) in the Metro Area began in November, and have continued monthly.

A small, but enthusiastic group of juniors attended the clinic on February 22 during the Highway 100 Pro-Am Tournament. A great group of pros helped instruct at this clinic including Bill Bredenbeck, Jim Frautschi, Chuck Gardner, and Cindy Tilbury. Dennis Ring and Jane Burkhardt deserve thanks for helping secure the needed courts. After stretching exercises, there were warm-up drills and playing time. Many of the students received individualize instruction, then could go watch a match and observe the strategies of the game.

Monthly clinics are being planned, but it looks like there will not be one in March due to Spring Break and Easter. The April clinic will probably be held on April 26 or April 27. The site will be announced and published at the **MSRA web site**.

ready and able to go after 30 seconds? Nor should the two minute allotment between games expand into five. Furthermore, the five minute break before the tiebreaker does not constitute a full wardrobe change.

After the score is called, ten seconds to put the ball in play should mean just that! The receiver is now at the mercy of the server. The only card dealt to the receiver is that he or she can dictate the pace of the server within the 10 second count. It is NOT the referee's responsibility to tell the server to check the receiver. An opponent holding up their racquet is probably not slowing the game down just to annoy or trap the receiver. More likely the person is trying to regain their composure

or recover from a long rally. And if your opponent is holding up their racquet just to annoy you, maybe you should not act so annoyed.

The dreaded avoidable hinder differs little from the call "foul" in basketball. With few exceptions, your attempt to get out of the way should not influence the call of an avoidable hinder. In basketball, five fouls (six in some) and you're out of the game. If you wish, wear your sweatpants in racquetball and collect as many avoidables as you like! Bottom line: you deserve to get penalized when you fail to get out of the way.

Time-outs, ten seconds, and avoidable hinder calls are just a

few of the rules which need to be applied more vigorously. We cannot continue to ignore half the rule book and expect tournament matches to progress smoothly.

Since when has asking for the enforcement of rules become a demonstration of unsportmanship? The ultimate in sportsmanship begins with knowledge of and staying within the boundaries of the rules. If you are willing to replay a point when blowing out an opponent 12 to 2, but refuse to do it at 10-10 in the tiebreaker, are you a good sport in the first example and insincere in the second? Or is it really the other way around....

# Court Sports Ranking System

Players begin with a default ranking when entering a new age or skill division. Every match played in an **MSRA sanctioned** tournament counts toward your ranking. For example: if you win in two games (15-5, 15-9), you have outscored your opponent by 16 points. If your opponent was ranked higher than you (an upset), your ranking goes up by 16 points and your opponent's goes down by 16. If your opponent is ranked lower than you, the difference in scores is split evenly: you go up by half and your opponent goes down by half. Scores for the lower ranked player are handicapped by one point for every 20 points difference in ranking, and are included in the lower ranked player's scores before the match result points are

awarded by the system which affect your ranking. The system is based on your ability to score points against a wide variety of opponents. Ranking printouts include your name, your "Rank Change" (how many cumulative points you have earned since September 1 of the current season), and your current ranking.

The Court Sports Ranking System program may be purchased on floppy disk for IBM compatible computers. Any club, YMCA, or individual interested in providing a ranking system for their players may call CSRS at (507) 753-2051.

to encourage the people playing to get involved. But how?

I certainly don't have all the answers, but I believe that to do something is better than to do nothing. Each of us have different talents and capabilities, so there is no single answer to that question anyway. Here are some suggestions:

\*\*Encourage more people to join the MSRA. The more members we have, the more people involved in the sport, and the better the communication between enthusiasts for the game. I know people who play the game weekly, but aren't members. Why? (Because they play no tournaments and aren't forced to join.)

\*\*Encourage more people to sign up and play tournaments, either smaller local ones, or the larger State Championships. Why don't more people sign up to play tournaments, even though they enjoy the game weekly? Some don't want to commit the time, which can be significant during a weekend tournament, but there are lots of smaller one day tourneys, too. I have friends that ride the Ironman, run a certain marathon, or ski the Birke each year. They play racquetball weekly, but don't sign up for the State Tournaments. Maybe they don't think they can win their division, but they aren't winning their "division" in these other sports either. Maybe they don't think they are "good enough", but there is a spot for everyone, even at a small tournament.

\*\*Encourage young people to play the game. I work with young people (I teach high school.), and I can tell you that they don't have a clue what the game is about unless they are playing regularly, and virtually none of them are doing that.

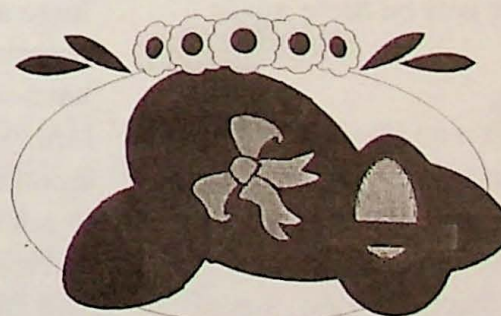
\*\*Encourage other adults to play the game. Do you talk about racquetball with friends who don't play or work associates?

\*\*Give a less talented player a few pointers. It's hard to do because people don't like to disturb other

people, but I think of a situation that happened this winter when I took my two daughters cross country skiing for the first time. Things went well....until the first hill. They sputtered, and I couldn't really help because they were too busy commenting on the stupidity of the sport to listen to me. Then the nicest man (he looked like a "pro" to me) stopped and got behind one of the girls and "gave her a lesson" on how to scale the hill. Then he helped the other girl. After that, they constantly improved. He didn't have to take 15 minutes of his recreational time to help them, but he put something back into the sport by improving their enjoyment of it. And I was in awe of him. Don't we need to try to help like this in our sport, too?

Our game has a low profile. Unlike tennis, golf, baseball, or basketball (to name just a few other sports) people don't get exposed to racquetball by driving down the street or turning on the TV. In fact, most people going to the club won't be exposed to racquetball unless they need to walk by the courts to get to another venue, which is unlikely. That is why each of us has to be an ambassador for the game.

So, are Juniors the future of our game? Of course they are a big part of the equation. But we also need more people already playing at a B or C level to become more active in tournaments. Maybe we need to clear the mistique that you have to win to qualify to play. You can have fun and get a great workout even if you don't win it all. The one sure thing is that if we don't take care of our sport, no one else will!

Larry Ranallo the owner of Legend's, is a member at the Hall of Fame Club and requested to have the banquet at his establishment. After the banquet, there were lots of calls and letters with rave reviews about the food and service. Larry and his staff did such a nice job, the banquet will be there again next year.

Marv Blair was introduced by Bill Hall. He played primarily at King's Court, Edina, when that was still open and now plays with the Normandale group (Bill Hall, Jim McCarthy, Jim Pastor, etc.). He loves to play so much that he made sure he could play in the "with hair" and "without hair" divisions. In doubles, he likes to play the right side, and his friends like to play with him because he has the reputation of being a team player who is dedicated to the sport of racquetball, but is also a fun guy on the court. instead of playing games to 15, you get to play 3 games to 11. The way you win is by keeping track of the points you gave up. So in a way, it's like golf - the low score wins.

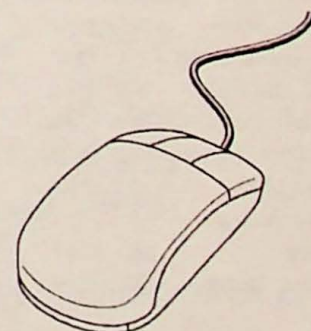

## **TOURNAMENT INFORMATION**

### **Rules**

USRA Official Rules will govern competition, including the mandatory use of protective lensed eyewear tested to ASTM F803 or CSA impact standards. Only U.S. citizens may compete in the open divisions.

### **Age Requirement**

For age division competition, players must meet the proper age requirement as of the first day of the tournament.

### **Who Must Play a Regional Event**

All players who intend to enter the U.S. National Singles Championships must pre-qualify at a regional championship – *with the exception of:* Women age 45 and over, Men age 55 and over, and junior/intercollegiate athletes who will qualify by competing in recognized Junior Regional or Intercollegiate Regional events in advance of the Nationals.

### **Amateur Status**

Only amateurs may participate. A professional is defined as anyone who has accepted prize money in the preceding 12 months, regardless of amount, in any IRT/WIRT pro-sanctioned tournament or any other event so deemed as professional by the USRA Board of Directors.

### **Membership**

A USRA competitive license membership is required of all participants. At registration, entrants must present a current membership card, a receipt, or a cancelled check indicating recent enrollment as proof of membership, or purchase a

competitive license membership on site. Reinstatement of amateur status may be requested if no money has been accepted for the past 12 months.

### **Open Division "One Serve" Rule**

The USRA requires that open divisions **only** be limited to one serve. The "one-serve" rule stipulates that players will be permitted only one serve to put the ball into play *but* that a single, screen serve will be ruled a deadball serve. A second consecutive screen serve will be a sideout

### **Skill Level Nationals**

Anyone who wishes to be certified for skill level competition at the 1997 U.S. Open Skill Level Nationals may request an AMPro skill rating at their regional qualifier. Contact the tournament director for more information.

### **Training Camps**

All quarterfinalists in the championship divisions will receive an invitation to the U.S. National Elite Training Camp. Extra events are not championship events for this purpose. Be sure to pick up your application at the tournament if you reach the qualifying round.
