Jim's left foot was crushed and left theigh protruded from flesh.

Just short of a week in the hospital, three operations were performed to piece the leg back together. It was then that Jim was inform by the doctor to face the fact that the thought of playing racquetball ever again would be impossible.

Hearing that statement from the doctor resulted into three days of depression which transformed into determination to play racquetball again. There were three long months in a wheelchair, infection set backs and countless operations which enabled Jim to achieve a goal to fulfill a dream.

If there was ever a worst opponent to compete against in the sport of racquetball or any sport for that matter, it would be the opponent of near death. Determined to beat the odds, this person came back and won.

Jim Lyman is now playing "A's" and Open Doubles. It is our pleasure to present the "True Grit" award to Jim Lyman. Congratulations!

Kelley Beane, a little over a year ago, was out for a bike ride. Kelley was accidentally hit by a truck. 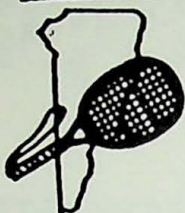
