Wilhelm wins state singles

The 1981-82 State Singles Championship, held April 16 through 18 at the Racquetball Action Club of Lansing, was the grand finale to the tournament season and the best "Singles" ever. Action began Friday at 4 p.m. for the first of 326 entrants and continued with good matches throughout the weekend.

Spectators and players alike again got to see Bob Wilhelm of Flint square off against Ray Vanover of Kalamazoo in the finals of the Men's Open. They also saw Debbie Erhart of West Bloomfield against Donna Henry of Novi in the Women's Open finals. Congratulations to Debbie and Bob for winning their respective divisions. Another tough division, Junior Boys 17 and Under, saw two usual Men's Open Players — Chuck Teets of Allen Park and Mike Magnoli of Warren — battle it out. Then the Men's Masters saw Lynn Hahn, from Whitehall, take an 11-7 tiebreaker to defeat two-time Masters State Champion Ron Puduck of Ann Arbor.

One of the most exciting matches of the tournament was the Men's Seniors A semi-final match between Tom Brownlee of Pinkney and Roy White of Grand Rapids. Tom won the first game 21-20 and Roy returned the favor by winning the second by the same score. Roy was ahead 7-1 in the tiebreaker and things looked bleak for Tom until someone in the crowd yelled "Tom, it looks like

you're going to be refing soon. Tom hates to ref, so he did the only thing left to avoid it, winning the tiebreaker 11-10. Congratulations to both men for an excellent effort.

We want to thank the Racquetball Action Club and our sponsors for doing a fine job at the State Singles. Thanks to Dr. Pepper for their money contribution and for providing free Dr. Pepper throughout the tournament. Thanks to Bata for their money contribution and for providing each division winner with a pair of Bata shoes. Thanks also to Ektelon for providing the balls and shirts for all tournament players and to Mountain Jacks for providing hospitality throughout the tournament.

Another exciting moment at the tournament happened off the courts. Debbie Nirganakis of Roseville was the grand door-prize winner Saturday, getting a \$100 bill Friday night's grand prize winner was Sue Pyles of Flint who won a Pentax 35mm camera. Congratulations to all the winners. The door prizes for the State Championships were purchased by the MRA.

This year at the states we tried some new concepts. One concept was losers refereeing instead of winners, which worked because of the support of all tournament players. Two, the MRA purchased matching shorts for all players,

which went over with great success.

And finally, in response to the complaints at last year's state singles about players being allowed to drop back into lower divisions, we made some changes in the rating system at the beginning of the year and kept a careful eye on all entries. This system is by no means perfect, but we think each

Racquetball is art to Wilhelm

Many areas and many sports, including Michigan, have had someone who has dominated a particular division. (Such as Stacy Fletcher, Larry Fox and Bob Lipin.) But this year, Michigan racquetball had the oddity of two people attempting to dominate its top division. Every time Bob Wilhelm and Ray Vanover entered an MRA tournament this season, they played in the finals. In four tournaments, including the State Championship, they played each other in the finals. Wilhelm won this personal

series 3-1, but that doesn't alter the accomplishments of either man.

To give Wilhelm and Vanover the notice they deserve, and to allow the membership to know these fine players better, we will publish an article on each. This issue will feature this year's state singles champion, Bob Wilhelm.

Bob Wilhelm currently lives in Flint, his hometown. He is married to Siri Gottlieb, a practicing attorney, and has a son, Aaron, 16

months. Bob and Siri soon are to be parents for a second time. This makes Bob not only one of the few top open-division players who is married, but one of an even smaller number who are parents.

Bob and Siri returned to Flint two years after Siri completed law school in Lansing. Bob graduated from the University of Michigan School of Art and Design. It was while in college that he began playing racquetball.

At first racquetball was a sport **cont. on page 2**

that Bob and Siri could enjoy together. That was further enhanced by a university rule in 1976 that only permitted doubles, wooden racquets and wooden walls. After a year, Bob felt the urge to try singles and enter tournaments. His first tournament had only one division. Not surprisingly, he got beaten, and beaten badly. Meanwhile, Siri became successful in her singles play, winning the state Women's C championship.

Bob kept improving and the last three years he has been considered one of the top open-division players in the state, with this year perhaps his best. Bob said there are a number of reasons for his continued success, and most of them are mental. The hard physical training occurred about four or five years ago, but didn't gel into winning until his mental game improved.

"This year, Bob had less time than ever to be on the court. He said 'I finally realized what I wanted out of the sport, and what part of my life it fits in.' He played in a few pro tournaments, but didn't enjoy them because his family ties are so strong. When he realized he could pick and choose the tournaments he played in, it reduced the pressure he put on himself and bettered his play."

Another mental aspect Bob had to learn was handling the pressure of being one of the best-known players in the state. He said he had to learn how to practice to get

something from each match. He also had to learn not to allow criticism to hurt him. He learned to ignore comments that he won because of an easy draw, or because of luck, he said.

Bob says that he doesn't have to put in as much court time now as before if he takes time to concentrate and be intense. He believes mental conditioning is as important as the physical. In fact, when he plays now, he often doesn't get pumped up. But he does prepare a game plan and concentrate on winning the match and thinking positively.

In his matches with Ray Vanover, Bob doesn't prepare any special way. The two have played so often, Bob said, that he just considers it another tough match. "I appreciate what makes him what he is," Bob said. "He wants to win and he is verbal to pump himself up. I know why he does what he does. And he knows why I do what I do." The only negative aspect of the matches with Vanover, Wilhelm said, is the desire to play someone else in the finals.

In addition to winning the state singles championship (plus the doubles) Wilhelm had his greatest racquetball thrill this year. In the Self Spaulding tournament in California, Bob played Craig McCoy in the round of 16. Bob beat McCoy 21-9, 21-5. McCoy then replied to a questioner that "the guy from Michigan took off his

sweats and beat me like he was warming up.' Wilhelm said he will never forget that.

Wilhelm is seriously considering his future both in racquetball and in work. He has a slightly damaged knee, and he wonders how long a man in his late 20s can hold off the young lions coming up. He considers racquetball an art form and

the game is an artistic release for him now. In addition to remodeling his house. But when the remodeling is finished, he plans to cut back on racquetball and resume his art career. If he displays the same skill and creativity in that profession that he does in racquetball, he is sure to reap similar recognition and rewards.

President's Corner

In this article, being the last of the 1981-82 season, I would like to talk about some of the new things, and I hope good things, that the MRA has done in the past season. We all can complain about that "terrible ref" we had at a certain tournament, or how we started an hour and a half late, or an awful draw at another tournament; but for now let's concentrate on some of the good things that happened this year.

1. This year we changed structurally the format of the entry form. Now when you fill it out and send the bottom half in, you can keep the top half for yourself with all the information on it instead of taking two entry forms like I used to do.

2. This year we started offering doubles matches at our tournaments. This is something we haven't offered in the past and we are going to continue it next year.

3. We sent out to all racquetball clubs our MRA color poster listing the dates and locations of our tournaments, including for the first time the date and location of the State Doubles Championship. I think it was without a doubt one of the most beautiful posters made. (Maybe I might be just a shade prejudiced on this matter.) A special thanks goes to Peggy and Gary Doty for getting all the dates, clubs, sponsors and logo information together for the poster. And a big thanks goes to Bob Wilhelm for taking all the information and physically putting it together and designing the poster.

4. This year the State Doubles, held at the Davison Racquet Club, ran well and most of the players enjoyed themselves. We gave everyone a can of balls this year, along with a tournament shirt, and ran a consolation bracket. This has not happened before at MRA Doubles tournaments.

5. We ran a couple of referees' clinics this year explaining the rules and how to enforce them as a referee. We had the clinics at the MRA tournaments in Lansing and Grand Rapids.

6. This year the State Singles Championship, held at Racquetball Action Club in Lansing, along with giving out a tournament shirt, the MRA bought and gave every player a matching pair of shorts. This was not done last year at the State tournament.

7. This year for the first time ever, the MRA donated \$500 from its treasury for door prizes at each tournament.

8. Loser's Ref!! This has been an overwhelming success. We started this new policy of making the

loser, instead of the winner, referee the following match on the court where they played. At the second stop in Mt. Clemens this was started and we have been doing it ever since. This concept was first put into practice in Michigan at a tournament in Lansing run by Dennis Wood, a past president of the MRA and has become more and more popular all season. Since the MRA established this policy in October, 1981, almost all of the tournaments held today in this state use the same rule and the majority of racquetball players love it.

9. On Sunday, April 25, the MRA, in conjunction with Special Olympics, held the first official "Racquetball Day" in Michigan as declared by the Governor. With the help of 33 different racquetball clubs across the state, we made some money and donated it all to the Special Olympics.

10. Last but certainly not least, I would like to comment on our newsletters. The newsletter you are now reading is number four for the 1981-82 season. In don't think the MRA ever had four newsletters in one season before now. Our newsletter has grown each time it has come out. Our first in September was small, just four pages. The second one, in December, was tabloid size with eight pages, and the third one, in March, was a whopping 12 pages. As I sit here writing this article, I have no way of knowing the size or quality of our fourth and final newsletter this season, but I have high hopes that it will be just as big and just as good as the other newsletters were. Also, our newsletters have tournament pictures and rule clarifications in them and this is another first.

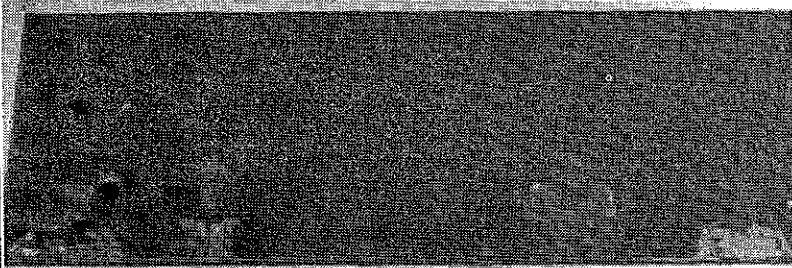

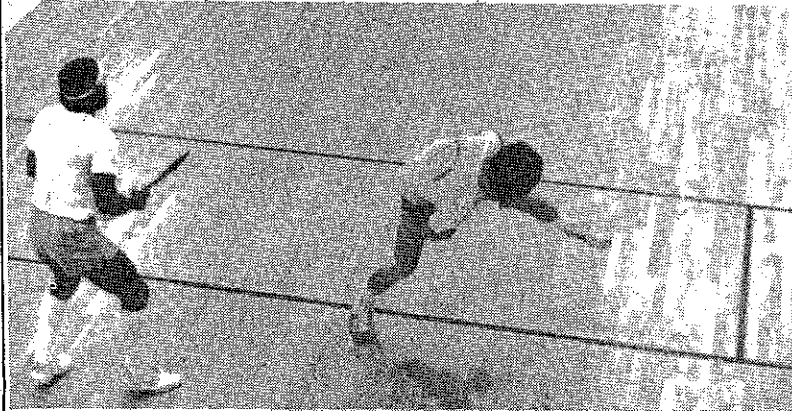

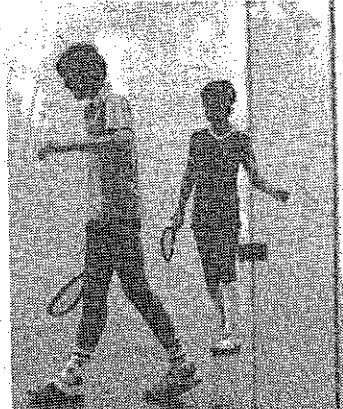

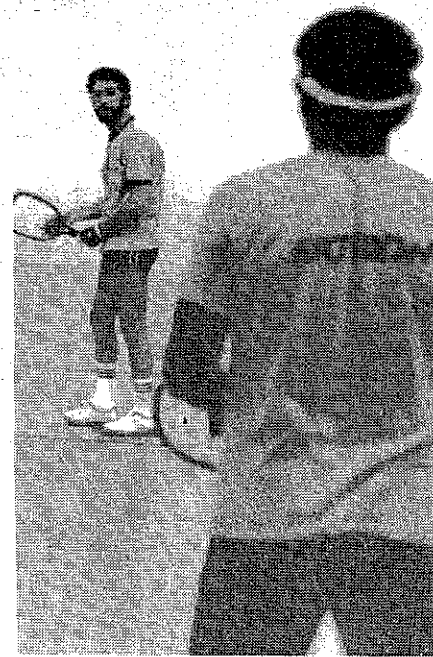

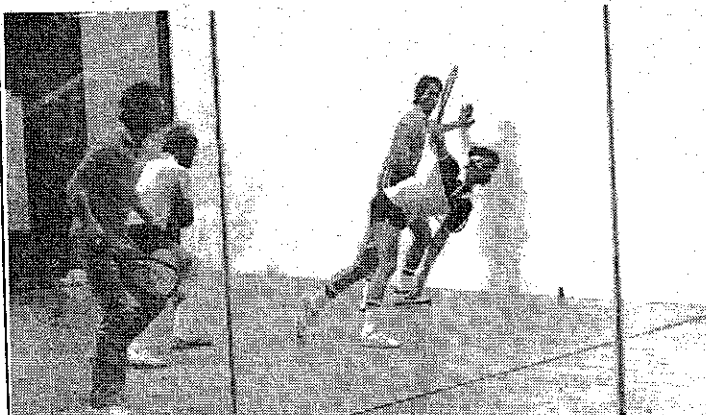
