This will be a new and improved Award Banquet. The main event will be the induction of the Class of 2004 and 2005 in the Racquetball Association of Michigan Hall of Fame. Tom Blakeslee was elected in 2004. He will be inducted in the Hall along with anyone voted in this year. There are several excellent candidates, and it will be great to see who gets voted in.

In addition to the Hall of Fame induction, we will also give out several other awards for achievement during the 2004-2005 season.
