

2. All players play two singles and one doubles match.

3. Each match won is recorded as a point and each match lost is recorded as a 0.
4. Team recording most wins is the champion.
5. All players must be a member of the club he or she represents.
6. Expenses of each event are to be split between all players from both clubs.

Let's talk racquetball

More and more people are picking up rackets these days but it's not the same as 10 years ago. The new racket is racquetball.

For the first few years racquetball, a grueling and ever-moving game, has experienced the same thing tennis went through in the early 1970s — a tremendous boom. And its popularity has grown so fast that it has quickly gained on tennis' 20-million plus participants.

"Racquetball in general is on the upswing," says Vernon 'Duke' Besse, the vice chairman of the Louisiana Racquetball Association (LRA). "It hasn't come close to its saturation point or its ultimate potential... and there's plenty of room for growth."

"I feel like we're (the LRA) really going in the right direction. In the last decade there's been a racquetball boom. But in the last three years it's taken off something unbelievable.

"Ten years ago," Besse points out, "there was an active (national) participation of something like 500,000. In the last poll taken, the number has grown to 14 million."

"It's probably one of the easiest sports you can learn in a short period of time and get the tremendous workout that you're hoping to get," he said.

Paul Bruno, a district representative for the LRA and part-owner in Racquetball One, concurs with Besse's assessment.

"It's almost like a piece of cake to play," says Bruno, who has been playing the sport for eight years. "Anybody who has just a little athletic ability can pick up a racket and reach a level of mediocrity in no time. And within four years you can become an 'A' player. It's just easy to play."

But hitting the ball against four walls and the ceiling isn't all there is to the game. Although it doesn't call for the finesse required by tennis, there is some skill involved.

"Racquetball has been refined to a certain extent," Besse says. "There are a lot of skill levels, but for a beginner I don't feel there's any comparison. If a beginning player stepped on a racquetball court, he's going to enjoy it a helluva lot more than tennis, and he's going to get a lot more out of it."

New Orleans has experienced a rush of interested players and club owners in the last few years. And although the increase has been well taken, there is still a pretty wide gap between New Orleans and other major racquetball cities.

"You go to Chicago or a big city in California... they've got clubs on almost every corner," Bruno says. "Chicago alone has about 39 clubs."

The LRA has had 22 sanctioned tournaments this year, according to Besse, but New Orleans, which was once considered the heart of the state for racquetball, has failed to make it to centre court: a pro circuit tournament for the city.


And the reason is that until Off The Wall Racquetball Club opened its doors a little over a month ago, New Orleans was without a professional viewing court.

Cliff Zeairs, co-owner of the club and holder of the LRA's top rating, has been in the business only three years, but has been playing the last 12. He says the idea of a pro-type court with a seating area had been in his plans for quite some time.

"The main thing," Zeairs says, "is that we're trying to get a pro stop here," adding that it may not be far off.

Zeairs is in the progress of getting a pro tournament at the Chalmette club. He said the contacts have been made, and he's tying up the loose ends. If everything goes well, the pros will make their first stop here in early 1982. "Hopefully, we'll have it ready for around Mardi Gras."

If it works out, and the pros do in fact make New Orleans one of their stops, it can only do one thing. Open up some eyes and cause another explosion in New Orleans.



AS THE TURNS

If you weren't around to watch the Open Final between Bill Land and Bo Champagne at the 6th Annual Wallbanger Invitational in June, you missed one of the most exciting local matches that anyone has had the pleasure to watch. At first it was a bit one-sided. Bill won the first game quite convincingly. In the second game Bo had only 14 points when Bill was serving at match point. Out of nowhere, Bo suddenly got this phenomenal spurt of energy (look, — it's a bird, it's a Plane!... no — it's Champagne!). The Romanian gymnastics team could have learned a few tricks from the moves he was pulling off. He seemed most effective when he was flat on the floor. Every time Bill would hit a shot that would appear to end it all, Bo would take a dive and miraculously pull another one out! Of course the spectators were loving every minute of it. At one point, even Bill had no choice but to applaud Bo's acrobatic performance. The second game was 21-20 — Champagne, and he went on to win the tiebreaker 11-6. Both men deserve to be congratulated for such a fine match. It was a real cliffhanger and crowdpleaser, and I thank you both for it! What better way to close out a tournament than with a fun match such as that?

If you become overly emotional and irrational on the court — this segment is for you. I think it's only fair to warn you racquet slammers and fist fighters that the LRA is fixin' to buckle down on poor sportsmanship! The negative displays in the past have been few and far between, but nevertheless, when they do occur, they dampen the otherwise festive spirit of everyone around. If you have a legitimate complaint — present it diplomatically to the Tournament Director. If you can't control your temper and must flail yourself wildly, be prepared — you may find yourself ejected from the tournament, and possibly — in extreme circumstances — banned from future competition for a set period of time. If you don't appreciate what I'm saying, picture the mental torment of the poor individual who has to referee the Jeter-Haney matches. It doesn't paint a very pretty picture. So... "You better watch out — You better not cry..."




