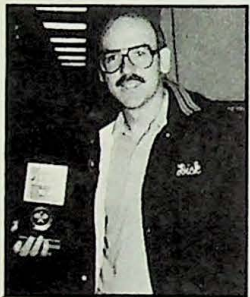

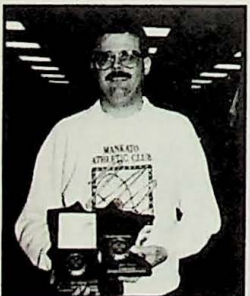

The Referee Certification program has been a huge success this year. We started the season with 29 certified referees, we now have 90 people certified---an increase of 61 or 310%.

I would like to thank a number of people who were instrumental in this success by making the test available, encouraging people to take it and reviewing the results with them. They are: Lois Anderson, Peggy Clark, Dave Hart, Greg Hayenga, Kelly Kirk and Dee Lichty.

Special thanks to those of you who took the time to study the rule book and take the certification test, in many cases more than once. 59 of you took the test at the State Singles tournament alone, 20 received a passing grade. This was a significant increase over last year when 42 people took it and 4 passed.

From the "Pres"

I knew that I was back in Minnesota on Memorial Day when we were greeted with snow while crossing the Iowa border. It was the end of our 4,000 mile car journey down the great river route to New Orleans, over to Houston for the National Singles tournament, and the 20 hour drive straight back. And we only got one speeding ticket. Much to my surprise, we discovered that you cannot see where the Mississippi River flows into the Gulf of Mexico, as the entire Louisiana Delta is owned by the oil companies! Ugh. For any of you explorer types, I'll tell you where the best (and cheapest) shrimp are found, as well as the best barbecue.

National Singles was kind of different this year. We missed Becky Shirk, Todd Stead, Hart Johnson, and Tim Lavoie: our "regulars". Newcomers Andrea and Brett Beugen, Dave Zabinski, and Terri Straka filled the gap admirably, and will surely be back again. This was the tenth anniversary of National Singles at the downtown Houston Y, and no one was allowed to forget. Last year all the war veterans had to stand up at the banquet as Desert Storm was winding to a close. This year all the "tenners" got the honors. I did my presidential duties by helping with posting tourney scores, talking to a lot of folks, and attending a rather lengthy membership meeting. Many of the issues raised by our membership and Board of Directors were addressed in this meeting.

Steve Lerner, AARA Treasurer, reports that the AARA is financially healthy again, with a net income of \$65,000. Cash flow continues to be a problem because of accounts receivable, but all shortfalls from last summer have been eliminated. Keith Calkins and Luke St. Onge, champions of the Olympic Dream, report that USOC funding (\$800,000 cash and in kind services) is guaranteed through 2007 due to the inclusion of racquetball as a full medal sport in the 1995 Pan Am Games. They continue to pursue demonstration status at the Atlanta Olympics, since Womens Softball was added. If that cannot be a reality, the World Championships will be held in Atlanta in 1996 as part of a non-Olympic Sports Festival. A nominating committee, headed by Mike Arnolt but including no current Board members, will select the slate of candidates for the 1993 AARA elections.

Our MSRA Board of Directors is seeking an interested individual to run for national office in order to have a more proactive role in decisions made by the national organization. If the MSRA membership solidly backed a candidate, we would have a strong possibility of getting that person elected, since it takes less than 1,000 votes. If you're interested in this challenge, and want to be more involved in the decisions made about the sport, call me at the office (920-6652) and let me know. We need to get 100 signatures to get your name on the ballot.

We will continue to make the test available at sanctioned tournaments whenever possible.

I would encourage everyone to become more familiar with the current AARA rules, whether you plan to become a certified referee or not. Knowledge of the rules makes you not only a better referee, but just as importantly, a better player.

There is a \$5 fee for referee certification, which is sent to the AARA office. Certified refs receive a pin and card from the AARA, attesting to their certification. You must hold a current AARA/MSRA competitive license (membership), to be certified.

If you are interested in taking the referee certification test, and have not found it available, contact me at (612) 430-3367 and I will make sure you have an opportunity to take it.
