# TOURNAMENT DIVISION QUALIFICATIONS, OR AUTOMATIC MOVE UP FOR DIVISION CHAMPIONS, OR "HEY, IF I WON LAST YEAR, WHY CAN'T I COME BACK TO DEFEND MY TITLE?"

It's been a while since we published the RAM policy on division eligibility for past champions and the "automatic move up" policy, so with State Singles coming up it seems about time. So, without further ado, here are the rules and guidelines regarding division qualifications.

If a player wins a tournament, they SHOULD be required to move up at that same event the following year.

If a player wins two local tournaments over any time period, they must immediately move up for all following local tournaments. At the next State Championship (Singles or Doubles), the player may play their former division one last time, but then they must return to the higher division.

If a player wins a State Championship, that player automatically moves up to the next higher division for all subsequent tournaments. This does not necessarily affect their level in the other discipline ie: A win at State Singles, does not necessarily mean the player has to move up in doubles, or vice versa.

If that player loses in the first round of the higher division at the following year's Championship, they may be allowed to return to the lower division after petitioning the Board.

All of these can be overridden by the tournament directors or the Board. It's up to the directors to properly place players to ensure fairness whenever possible.

We all like to win tournaments and it's really cool to defend your title. However, it's much cooler to achieve and advance, sharpen your skills and challenge yourself to get better and better. You don't have to win a tournament or State Championship in order to move up. The goal is to be fair to everyone else in those divisions. Please do your best to help us, as it really is in the best interest of the sport.

## 2012 MAC OPEN - SPECIAL GUESTS MAKE FOR A SPECIAL WEEKEND




