## Membership

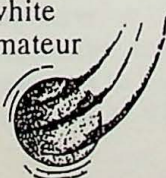


As we enter our busiest racquetball season, concluding with State Singles at the end of April, many of you will find renewal notices from the AARA in your mailbox. The AARA sends these red, white and blue notices to your home three months and one month before your membership renewal date. The AARA is the national governing body for the sport of racquetball, and authors the Racquetball Magazine you receive approximately every two months. Your \$15 membership renewal supports the AARA with \$9 and our local state organization with \$6. While we appreciate the service the AARA provides by reminding you that your membership is due for renewal, we ask that you renew through our office or at your favorite tournament.

To put it simply, our request is financially oriented. The \$6 that we receive of each membership goes into the production of the newsletter and defrays administrative costs. Please remember that all Board members are volunteers and receive no salary for their time. Our only paid staff is an Administrative Assistant, a junior player paid the same wages as a babysitter. When you renew through the mail to our office (P. O. Box 16515, St. Louis Park, MN 55416-0515) or at a tournament the \$6 portion of your \$15 goes straight into our checkbook. When you renew through the AARA National offices, a different process occurs. The AARA adds up all the money due back to each state on a quarterly basis, notifies us by mail of the amount of money earned, and then allows us to deduct their \$9 portion of membership until the debt is satisfied.

If a significant number of renewals go through the AARA in January, February and March, we have only the month of April to catch up on the money due us from the AARA. The three or four sanctioned tournaments during the summer may not eradicate the balance due from the AARA. It may be the next tournament season before we "collect" the \$6 of your competitive license. We have four newsletters, including this one, which need to be published before State Doubles in October. The calendars for next year are printed over the summer months as well. We think we have enough money in the Treasury to do the job, but every renewal we initiate gets us closer to the goal.

**YOU CAN HELP!** Renew your membership as soon as possible through the MSRA office or at the next tournament. Just bring in that red, white and blue notice and we'll do the rest! Thanks for your support of amateur racquetball in Minnesota and the Olympic Dream.

# From the "Pres"

This year I attended my fourth leadership seminar hosted by the AARA in Colorado Springs. Presidents and key Board members from 27 states shared ideas and concerns with each other and the national staff. Many new faces with fresh enthusiasm were present, along with experienced attendees. In keeping with the current economic times, we looked at our resources and goals, and achieved some consensus in the future direction of the organization.

Due to reduced funding from the US Olympic Committee, state grant funds and television coverage for the balance of this fiscal year were eliminated. Steve Lerner, the new Director of Marketing, is charged with soliciting outside sponsors and improving the magazine circulation to produce more advertising income. The focus of the AARA will redirect toward the recreational player and grass roots development, while attempting to maintain dominance in world competition. Junior Team USA is doing their own fund raising for a trip to Europe (see Andrea Beugen for details). The recreational membership program will be heavily marketed, and could be well received by clubs in Minnesota. Modifications requested by the leadership seminar group will be voted on by the AARA Board of Directors in May. Statistics presented showed that the costs of servicing a member are \$22, recreational and competitive alike. Hints were strong that competitive license fees may be increased to maintain service. Many other sport organizations charge more for their competition licenses than racquetball. The athlete insurance deductible increased to \$2,000 due to the vast number of claims submitted. Although the financial picture is not rosy at the AARA, I was glad to see the financial issues addressed in a responsible fashion.

Our state organization is making progress toward balancing our budget. We hope that the Regional Tournament will generate most of the income to cover our shortfall this year. You may have noticed that we have offered doubles and mixed doubles to encourage more participation. Jim Murphy's high school kids from St. Louis probably will come up that weekend, expanding the number of junior players. We are offering an optional shirt like we do at State Tournaments. The Regional Tournaments are the major fund raiser for the AARA each year, with five dollars of every entry sent directly to the AARA. We are trying to keep the prices affordable for the tournament even with the five dollars we must commit to the AARA. Dave Hart is our social director for this event, and we hope to have matches complete in time for a social gathering Saturday evening.

**Please remember that we encourage you to renew your competitive licenses through our post office box or at the tournaments.** The MSRA may wait up to five months to have access to our \$6 portion of the license if renewed through the AARA. We like to keep the amount due back from the AARA at a minimum to avoid a cash flow problem in our state. As we enter our busiest part of the tournament season, I wish you all good luck. You'll be happy to know that the referee certification test was changed to 50 questions, so it will be easier to pass the test to earn the higher ref rate at state and regional tournaments. I hope to see you at one of them!

## Eyeguard Update

Have you ordered those prescription eyeguards yet? Or have you switched to contact lenses and regular **lensed eyeguards designed for racquet sports**? You thought we were just kidding, didn't you? Please schedule this important item in your budget. Please practice with the new eyeguards before you play in your first tournament and experience the frustration of competition while making the transition. While we have encouraged you to make lensed eyewear a priority in your racquetball equipment, we have given you fair warning that we mean business on this subject. By State Doubles in October, we will check your eyewear before you enter the court. Be prepared! Did you know that squash is the leading cause of blindness in England? Why? Could it have anything to do with the lack of mandatory eyewear?

Eyeguards have been mandatory in AARA sanctioned events for the last five years. The number of people who still play tournaments without eyeguards is diminishing, but they are still out there. Even open players get hit by the racquet or the ball occasionally. When you consider that most adults can hit the ball in excess of 100 miles per hour, some as high as 160, can you think of a reason not to have eye protection?
