RULE UPDATES

Effective January 1, 1991, the LRA modification of the 5-foot safety line will follow the current AARA ruling.

The basic difference in the receiving line rule is now you may break the plane of the line once the ball bounces. The server must be aware that it is his/her responsibility to allow the receiver an offensive opportunity at balls that do bounce inside this zone.

The AARA has also ammended its rule regarding foot faults. It is now acceptable for part of the foot to extend beyond either line of the service zone provided that some part of both feet is on or inside the lines from the moment the service motion begins until the served ball passes the short line.

The LRA also plans to offer the AARA referee certification test during the scholarship tournament in January.

JUNIORS RACQUETBALL

A good, solid juniors racquetball program is the best way to ensure the growth of racquetball for years to come. A juniors racquetball council has been formed by the LRA and we have come up with some alternatives on how to promote and increase the number of junior racquetball players statewide.

The first alternative would be for each club pro to form a juniors racquetball league which would also include some instruction.

After leagues have been formed, a juniors racquetball team from each club could be formed, which would compete against other teams in a citywide tournament. This would lead to a statewide juniors tournament sometime in the future.

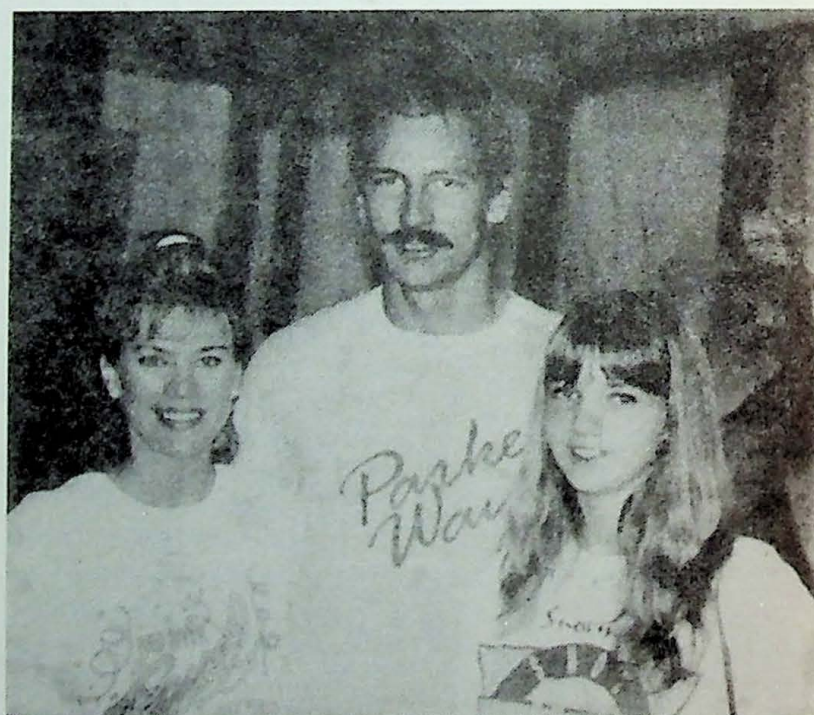

P.A.R.I PLAYING TIPS BY FRAN DAVIS

Developing into a good all-around racquetball player is like building a house. In order for that house to be steady and solid, you need to build it from the ground up. The foundation and frame must be set before putting on the roof. The same is true in racquetball. You must set a solid foundation (stroke development) before building up to strategy, shot selection, court position, etc.

In future issues, we will be covering stroke development, strategy, shot selection, court position, serve and serve return, and relocation out of the box.

A methodical approach will make you a more consistent, steady player. Remember, whether building a house or your racquetball game, if your foundation is not solid, it will not be structurally sound. Be patient. The best players don't learn overnight.
