RULE UPDATES

With the State Singles just a few weeks away, now is a good time to get out the rule book and brush up on our refereeing skills. Here are a few case studies taken from the text of "Officiating Racquetball" by Jim Hiser and Otto Dietrich. See if you can make the call.

Case Study #A4

The server occasionally hits a high z-lob serve on his second serve. The receiver decides to return this serve with a ceiling ball for the entire first game. The first time the server uses this serve in the second

game, the receiver moves up to short hop the ball, but holds up because the server is in the way. Whats the call?

Answer: Rule 4.16

Its point hinder for failure to move. The server is always responsible for knowing what the receiver is doing and to get out of the way to allow the receiver to shoot the ball. The referee should either explain this before the match or immediately after the first hinder occurs.

Case Study #B1

Player A is setting up to hit a cross court pass shot. As player A finishes his swing, his racquet contacts player B, who immediately stops, not even attempting to retrieve the pass shot. Player B asks for a hinder. Should the referee give player B the hinder?

Answer: Rule 4.15

If player B could have returned the ball, but didn't because of the contact, then hinder would be the proper call. However, if the contact was caused by player B's having taken a position to close to player A, then the contact would not be considered a hinder. The follow through is a normal extention of the offensive players motion. Referees should not be fooled and fall into the trap of allowing the defensive player to dictate the call. Use your judgement to decide whether the defensive player was to close.

The LRA staff will offer the AARA Referee Certification test during the State tournament. In future events where referees are paid for their services, certified referees will receive \$5.00 while non-certified referees receive \$3.00.
