Points System Changes

Posting of Doubles Points

In the past, doubles and singles competition points were recorded separately. However, the points were added together and posted as one number under Singles standings.

It has been brought to our attention that Doubles and Singles points should be posted separately in order to get a true picture of all competitors rankings.

In the future, players will be seeded by points earned from Singles competition. When rankings are published the Doubles and Singles points will be posted separately.



Reminder of Rule Changes

Loss of Equipment During A Rally:

If a player loses any piece of equipment during a rally, play should immediately come to a halt and an Avoidable Hinder should be charged to the player who lost the equipment.

However, if the player's opponent is responsible for causing the equipment loss, the call will be either a Dead-Ball Hinder or Avoidable Hinder on the player who caused the equipment loss.

Encroachment

Just as the receiver hits a perfect return of serve (rollout), the referee calls the receiver for encroachment of the Receiving Line. The receiver appeals the call and wins the appeal. Two serves are then given to the server instead of the receiver being declared the winner of the rally.

Moving Up In Your Division

How The Draw Size Affects You

In all cases, the size of the draw in each tournament division determines whether or not winning the division will require a player to move up to next division. A player can continue to compete in, and win, a division as long as the division does not have at least eight players in it. It is very difficult to justify a requirement for a winner to move up if the division they won had seven players or less in it.

In the posting of tournament results you will see two items that will tell you whether a division was "full" or not. The division heading may read "Women's Combo Open/A" or the heading of the division may be followed by parenthesis (7) with a number enclosed. This number tells you how many player were in the division.

Getting A State Ranking

You Can Make The System Work Better.

Have you ever wondered what your NHRA ranking is, or how you get it? Well, here is a short explanation.

Each time you enter an NHRA/AARA sanctioned tournament, and finish in the top eight in your division, you receive ranking points. It is the responsibility of each tournament director to submit complete tournament results to the NHRA within ten days of the event. The results are carefully checked by the NHRA to ensure that all information is correct before the results are sent on to AARA National Headquarters in Colorado Springs, CO for inclusion into the national rankings system. This process is important for you to receive credit for all the points you earn. Your name and state code must be EXACTLY the same each time you earn points or your state and national rankings will be incorrect. For example: Joe Smith, NH might have been submitted as J. Smith, NH; Joe Smith, MA; or Joseph Smith, NH. The computer at National Headquarters will have a ranking for each of those names! Eliminating duplications such as this is the biggest reason the tournament results are checked by Lenny and Gayann before forwarding them to the AARA.

You can help eliminate incorrect entries at each tournament. **Make sure when you enter each tournament that you use the name that appears on your AARA membership card.** This is the way that you appear in the AARA's computer. Then, if you see your name spelled incorrectly, or if you are assigned the wrong state code, tell the tournament director immediately and make sure it is corrected before the tournament ends. It is also important that you ask the tournament director how third and fourth place will be decided if there is no playoff. Since you only receive points for third and fourth if there is a designated winner, at least have the tournament director arrange for a coin toss to determine who gets which place.
