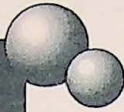

MEN'S PROFILE

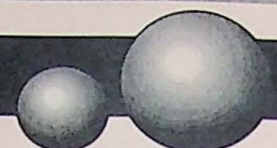
• John Schiavi •

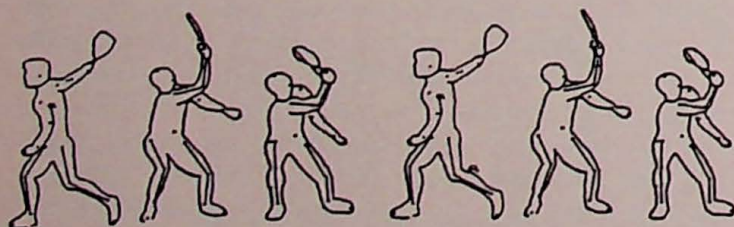

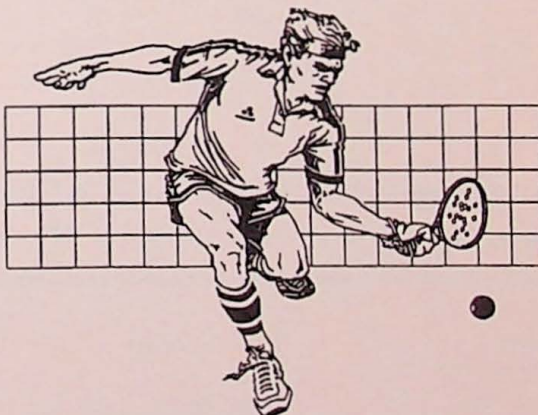
STRATEGIC VARIATIONS

Court Coverage

You must be in the basic ready position - feet shoulder width apart, weight forward on the balls of your feet, knees slightly bent, waist area slightly bent, and head and eyes watching the ball and/or opponent. The racquet is held either at the body midline or slightly to your backhand side. Be light and bouncy on your feet, so you can move quickly.

Watch your opponent. Many players telegraph the shot they are going to take - watch body movement, racquet and feet position. Watching closely allows



you to react to the ball as soon as it leaves your opponents racquet.

Controlling center court - after playing a shot your movement should always be toward center court, because you can control the game from the position.

Anticipation - watch your opponent closely. Analyze their likes and dislikes and which shots they use in particular situations. Another factor to look for in anticipating a shot is the position of your opponent in the court. If your opponent is deep, most shots will probably be passes or ceilings. If your opponent is forward, look for kills.

Most importantly - WEAR EYEGUARDS and watch the ball.

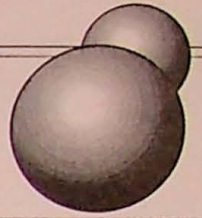

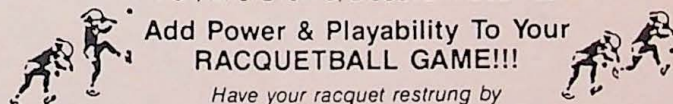
