WART'S

This is the eagerly awaited conclusion to the article on Wart's from the May Newsletter. The last column discussed the causes and symptomatology of warts. This column will discuss treatments.

The most common treatment is acid applications. These will slowly destroy the wart. The problem is in protecting the surrounding skin and getting down to the bottom of the wart without causing too much pain. This can be verytime consuming. More quick and successful treatments include surgical excision and hfercation (burning).

No one treatment is always successful, but a skilled professional will have an 80-90% cure rate. Some people think there is a psychological basis for treatments, using the power of suggestion. This can work well with children.

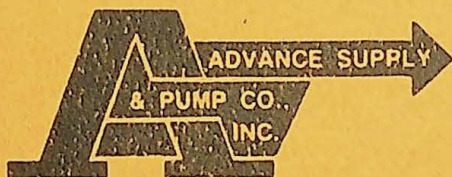
Many warts disappear for no apparent reason. If yours doesn't, it may be time to get some help.
