

Your safety is our number priority at Winning Touch Tennis so please read about our COVID-19 Rules and Guidelines. Note that we are closely monitoring the ever-changing recommendations on a daily basis in order to provide the latest information and guidelines from the CDC, Pennsylvania Health Department, and the USTA.

In addition to posting COVID signage throughout the building and on the nets, sending email notifications and Court Reserve global announcements, and using social media both Facebook and the WTT [website](#), we are currently using approved chemicals daily particularly in high traffic areas. We provide sanitizers in the common areas, but strongly suggest you keep your personal sanitizer and wipes in your tennis bag for your equipment and hands.

Please see the information below and we recommend that you read all COVID-19 Rules and Guidelines as well as the following links as resources for your safety.

- All Players MUST check in at the Front Desk
- Player Profile waiver must be signed prior to playing on the Tennis Courts
- Masks must be worn in lobby and gathering/common areas/playing on the courts.
- Please sanitize hands prior to entering the courts
- Please wash hands for a minimum of 20 seconds upon arrival
- Maintain social distancing as best as possible
- No sharing of equipment or touching celebrations
- No congregating in the common areas
- If you have been sick in the last 24 hours, please stay home
- *If you have or somebody you have come in contact with has visited a state listed on The Pa Health Department travel advisory in the past two weeks, you are not permitted to enter the club*
- Open court rental must use a NEW can of balls – no used balls
- Must bring your own water or purchase a bottle of water at the Front Desk

In addition to the club rules and guidelines we are also following the recommendations of the Pennsylvania Department of Health, CDC, and USTA
