TYRRELLS EQUINE CLINIC RING (Ridden)



Judge: Mrs Tracey Peverell
Ring to commence at 9am

- Class 1 TACK AND TURNOUT
Open to all, including lead rein. To be judged on the overall appearance of both horse and rider
- Class 2 LEAD REIN
Horse/Pony to be 4 years and over. Riders not to have attained 9 years before 1st January 2018. To be led and shown in a snaffle bridle
- Class 3 NOVICE RIDDEN
Open to any horse/rider combinations who have never won a showing class. Competitors will only be required to walk and trot. Double Bridles not permitted.
- Class 4 LOCAL RIDING HORSE/PONY
Open to any horse or pony from within a 15 mile radius of the showground. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces.

Judge: Ms Vicki Green

- Class 5 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREED RIDDEN
Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland. Horse/Pony to be 4 years and over
- Class 6 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREED RIDDEN
Welsh C & D, Connemara, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Highland. Horse/Pony to be 4 years and over

Judge: Mrs Tracey Peverell

- Class 7 RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY
Open to any horse or pony who is suitable to be a member of a riding club. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces, to include a small jump.
- Class 8 RIDDEN HUNTER TYPE
Open to any Horse or Pony over 4 years old. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces
- Class 9 RIDDEN COLOURED
Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Odd-Coloured, Roan, Dun and Spotted. Horse/Pony must be 4 years and over. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces
- Class 10 RIDDEN VETERAN HORSE/PONY
Open to any horse or pony 15 years and over. Competitors will be required to ride a show in all 3 paces.
- Class 11 RIDDEN FOREIGN BREED
Open to any breed not native to Great Britain. Horse/Pony must be 4 years and over.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to 1st and 2nd placed competitors in classes 1-11

Ring to commence at 9am

- Class 12 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREED IN HAND
Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland – 1,2 or 3 year old colt, filly or gelding
- Class 13 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREED IN HAND
Welsh C & D, Connemara, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Highland – 1,2 or 3 year old colt, filly or gelding
- Class 14 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREED IN HAND
Welsh A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland – 4 years and over stallion, mare or gelding
- Class 15 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREED IN HAND
Welsh C & D, Connemara, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Highland – 4 years and over stallion, mare or gelding

- Class 16 YOUNGSTOCK IN HAND
Open to horse/ponies 1, 2 and 3 years old
- Class 17 BEST CONDITION IN HAND
Open to any Horse or Pony over 4 years old.
- Class 18 BEST YOUNG HANDLER
Open to all handlers 14 years and under
- Class 19 VETERAN IN HAND
Open to any horse or pony 15 years and over.
- Class 20 COLOURED IN HAND
Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Odd-Coloured, Roan, Dun and Spotted. Horse/Pony must be 4 years and over.
- Class 21 FOREIGN BREED IN HAND
Open to any breed not native to Great Britain. Horse/Pony must be 4 years and over.
- Class 22 LOCAL HORSE/PONY IN HAND
Open to any horse or pony from within a 15 mile radius of the showground. Class may be split horse/pony if entries permit

- Class 24 **WORKING HUNTER PONY**
Open to ponies not exceeding 14.2hh. Competitors will be required to complete a small course of jumps with a maximum height of 2'3"
- Class 25 **WORKING HUNTER HORSE**
Open to horses over 14.2hh. Competitors will be required to complete a small course of jumps with a maximum height of 2'6"

General Show Rules

1. Competitors enter at their own risk. The organisers cannot be responsible for any accident, loss or injury to any animal, competitor, their assistants, property or spectators however caused.
2. The committee reserve the right to cancel any class or substitute any judge.
3. The committee reserve the right to reject or cancel the entry or entries made by any person if they deem it fit to do so.
4. The committee reserve the right to restrict entries in any class should numbers warrant.
5. The judge's decision is final.
6. Horses and ponies are liable to be measured if required.
7. Horse and ponies may have their passports checked.
8. Classes may be split into Horse / Pony sections if entries permit
9. No person other than the Show Officials and competitors at the time of competing are allowed in the show ring.
10. Competitors are not allowed to exercise their horses within the spectator areas and should keep to the horsebox area or any other designated area.
11. No galloping on the showground is permitted.
12. The correct attire, footwear and riding hats should be worn at all times when riding.
13. Unless a time has been specified in the schedule, classes follow on from each other immediately and it is the responsibility of the competitor to be ready to compete when the class is called.
14. Objections must be made within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 which will be returned should your objection be upheld. Any objection will be considered by the committee whose decision is final, from which there will be no appeal.
15. The area reserved for parking on the Horse Show site is reserved for Horseboxes and Horse Trailers only.
16. No refunds will be given after the close of entries unless the withdrawal is accompanied by either a doctor or vet's certificate. There will be no refund of entries taken on the day.
17. All trophy winners will be required to pay a deposit of £20.00 which will be fully refundable on return of the trophy the following year.
