LAKES ARE NOT SUPERVISED – it is your responsibility to assess the risk before going on the water.



Lake access is only for homeowners and guests staying at Lower Mill Estate. No entry for members of the public.



All homeowners and guests MUST adhere to the Estate Rules and Regulations (a copy can be found in each house and at the Estate Office)



A red flag safety system is in operation. When the red flag is raised, do not enter the water. Red flags are located at the launch points on Spinney Lake, Minety Lake, Howells Mere Lake and both north and south jetties on Somerford Lagoon.

Exit the water immediately if experiencing signs of cold-water shock (e.g., uncontrolled breathing, shivering or confusion).



Lakes are accessible during daylight hours only.
