3. Report by Ed Grosswiler

Rodent and rat problem (Ed). We have a treatment program now in place, with the worst problem in building B. (Bob) I heard rats a month ago... but the problem has subsided. (Ed) Unit 3 will have shared cost associated with dry rot. Vinyl siding has been improperly installed and was fixed. We are getting an evaluation whether the same problem exists elsewhere and estimates. (Dorothy Carroll) Are we contacting the siding company (Ed) we are currently in discussions with them to fix the problems, but have had only sporadic success on past problems. The problem could exist in every unit.
