Simple Chat

The chat page will open in "General Chat" which is shown in the white band across the top. The other options are "Channels" and "Direct", we will ignore these options for now.

To sign in, click on the "head" icon to the left of "Post a comment" at the bottom of the page. A form will be displayed and it will ask for your email, ignore the Facebook, Twitter and Gmail icons, put in your email address and click on continue. This brings up the "Complete your profile" form.

On this form enter your Name, a Username (can be the same as your Name) and a password of your choice (easily remembered is best). Click "Continue". You are now registered and logged in.

You can now type in the "Post a comment" box and then either press enter on you keyboard or click on the "Blue arrow" on the right of the screen to make you comment public.

To log out of the chat room, click on the "Three dots" at the top right hand side of the screen and then click "Logout"

The next time you want to sign in, click on the "head" icon, you will be asked for your email and password and again you are ready to chat.

It is that simple!

Advanced Chat

In this chat you can also put Emoji's and GIF's onto your comments, these are actioned by clicking the appropriate button next to the "Blue arrow".

There are (at the moment) two rooms in this chat, "General Chat" and "For Sale or Wanted", you can switch between rooms by clicking on "Channels" at the top of the page and then selecting the room you want to enter.

I can put on more rooms if needed, so if you have a suggestion for a room then let me know.

You can message a member privately by clicking on "Direct" and selecting the member that you want to message.
