 - Create and design test cases for the new features of the product (for both the front end and backend). I was involved mainly in the backend features such as: database load balancing and failover, checkpointing, performance and improvements.
 - Help in the development of testing tools to generate large amounts of data for the performance testing. We generated large amounts of objects to simulate common users actions. To create these tools we used K programming language.
 - Develop automated tests (mainly working with JUnit). I developed the complete test suite for a feature with no user interface. This feature was testable only by custom code in java. I used JUnit.
 - Work on investigating specific cases from clients. At early stages, clients had stability problems, most of the times related to the backend. After customer support, we were the next point of contact to solve problems before an issue was considered a high priority defect and raised to become a patch or a hotfix.
