	<b>1</b>	<b>Student's valid permit (NOT EXPIRED)</b>
	<b>2</b>	<b>Driver Education Course Completion Certificate</b> * "DE-964" form from Course provider. <i>The title of the form should be: "Texas Driver Education Certificate" – "FOR DRIVER LICENSE ONLY"</i>
	<b>3</b>	<b>Copy of Instructional Driving Log(s)</b> * Driving School - 30-hour parent log * Parent-Taught - 30-hour parent driving log
	<b>4</b>	<b>ORIGINAL - "Impact Texas TEEN Drivers" (ITTD) video certificate</b> * Must be dated within 90 days of the testing date (expiration date should be displayed on certificate) * Click here to link to access the video. <a href="#">IMPACT TEXAS TEEN DRIVERS VIDEO</a>
	<b>5</b>	<b>Texas Liability Insurance Card for car driven in the Road Test</b> * Insurance card must show current effective dates, cannot be expired * NO ELECTRONIC COPY ACCEPTED (MUST BE PRINTED COPY) * The VIN # on the insurance card must match the VIN # on the registration sticker AND the car itself * Car must be listed on the liability insurance card and the student cannot be listed as an excluded driver
Check box when verified	<b>CAR INSPECTION - Texas State Law requires these items to be inspected on the car before the test can be administered.</b>	
	<b>1</b>	<b>Current Non-Expired Registration Sticker on windshield</b> * A new car with 1 non-expired Texas Buyer's PAPER License Plate on back and no registration sticker is ACCEPTABLE
	<b>2</b>	<b>These items must be in working order</b> * Working Horn * Working Brake Lights and Turn Signals * Seat Belts must be present and worn during test * At least one mirror must be intact (rearview or outside)
	<b>3</b>	<b>Working Headlights, Tail Lights and Windshield Wipers</b> * If current conditions require them at the time of the test
	<b>4</b>	<b>Front Driver &amp; Passenger Doors must be present and open from the inside &amp; outside</b>
	<b>5</b>	<b>Proper License Plates</b> * 2 Metal Plates - affixed to outside <b>on the bumper</b> - FRONT and BACK; <b>OR</b> * If it is a newly purchased vehicle, a non-expired, paper "Texas Buyer's Plate" is allowed on rear of the car
<b>THESE FORMS ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR THE TEST AT GLDA - BUT THEY WILL BE REQUIRED AT THE DPS TO GET YOUR LICENSE</b>		
<b>1</b>	<b>VOE (Verification of Enrollment)</b> - this is provided by the student's school if under age 18	
<b>2</b>	<b>DL-14A or DL14-B - Application for Driver's License</b> – this can be picked up at the DPS office when you arrive
