

Green Light Driving Academy Teen Driving Program Tuition Payment Options

Green Light Driving Academy is happy to provide several tuition payment options for the teen driving program. Tuition can be paid in full or via partial payments. Any discounts are applied to obtain the final tuition amount.

PAYMENT TYPES

Payments can be made via:

- Cash (please bring exact change if possible)
- Check drawn on a local bank. We do accept post-dated checks, however, they cannot be dated more than 2 weeks from the date of registration.
- Credit Card (Master Card, Visa, or Discover). A 3% convenience fee is added for any credit card payment that is made.
- We do not accept money orders or cashier's checks.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Please refer to our payment options listed below:

On-Line Registration: Tuition Payment is paid in full at time of registration using a credit card and the 3% fee is automatically added.

In-Person Registration (registration at our office or at one of our on-campus registration events): If registering in person, you may use one of the following payment plans (any part of payment made by credit card will have the 3% fee added):

- Pay In Full Amount of tuition is paid in full, via the payment types listed above.
- Split or Partial Payments Tuition is split into multiple payments using the payment types as described below.

Split Payment (Option 1)	One Half (1/2) of Tuition is paid at Registration and the other half paid by the last day of the classroom session. If the balance of the tuition is NOT paid by the time the class session is over, \$20 will be added to the balance due.
Split Payment (Option 2)	\$100 minimum paid at time of Registration and the balance paid by installments: \$100 can be paid by check or cash and the balance will be paid in equal installments by credit card. A fee of 28% of the balance of the tuition will be added to the balance and figured into the installments. You can set any number of installments as long as the full tuition is paid by the time the student is finished with the program. If there is a default on any of the payments, the full tuition becomes due immediately.
