Gold'Hen 4-3-3 combats the wear and tear on high traffic grass areas. It nourishes the plants, making them more tolerant to stressful conditions like wind, water, traffic and heat stress.

Gold'Hen 4-3-3 is manufactured under strict guidelines, with frequent testing to ensure the product is free from any harmful toxins. It is safe for the environment and safe for our families and pets who are running barefoot on the grass. There are no chemical binders or additives in this product, it is fully approved for use on organic farms.

Application Rates & Instructions:

- **Garden**
 - Use 5 lbs. or 15 cups per 100 sq. ft. for vegetables and annual flowers.
 - Use 3 lbs. or 9 cups per 100 sq. ft. for perennials, legume vegetables, or herbs.
- **Established Lawn**
 - Spread 5 lbs. or 15 cups per 100 sq. ft. evenly, 2 – 4 applications per growing season. Application rate depends on length of season and clipping management.
- **Compost Starter/Activator**
 - Mix 1 lb. – 3 lbs. or 3-9 cups per compost pile. Amount will depend on the size of the pile and management. Mix into compost every 2-3 weeks.

The best results are achieved in conjunction with other Yard Farm Bermuda fertilizers and with an adequate, clean water supply. Gold'Hen 4-3-3 will not burn, even if over-applied. It may be spread on non-irrigated areas to await next rainfall.
