ANTHOLOGY CHURCH LAUNCHES STRONG IN CHARLES TOWN, WV





On the last Sunday of September, 178 people were in attendance on opening day for Anthology Church at the Charles Town Middle School. This number included 33 in the children's ministry. Over their first four weeks, Anthology has maintained an average of over 150. Of the 65 Connect Cards gathered after the inaugural service, 13 people indicated interest in being baptized!

Senior Minister, Curtis Teel, prepared over the past year to launch well by completing a church planting residency with another Waypoint church plant, Collective Church, in Frederick, MD, simultaneous with a distance training residency with Passion for Planting at New Life Christian in Chantilly, VA.

Charles Town, a town of 10,000, sits at the very eastern tip of the West Virginia panhandle, and is now considered to be part of the northwestern fringes of the Washington, DC metropolitan area. Charles Town is listed by some demographic reports to be West Virginia's fastest-growing city, having doubled in size since 2000.

WAYPOINT PARTNER CELEBRATES 250 YEARS!


Cool Springs Christian Church, located in rural Lunenburg County, in south-central Virginia, hosted a special anniversary celebration in October, recognizing its 250th birthday. Founded during Revolutionary times in the Fall of 1775, Cool Springs' preacher, Dave Richmond, a former Waypoint Board member, loves to quip, "We're older than America!"

Those familiar with Restoration Movement history might recall the famous "Lunenburg Letter" written in 1837 to Alexander Campbell by an unnamed female member of the Cool Springs Church. Her theological question to Campbell was answered in The Millennial Harbinger, Campbell's popular Christian magazine distributed between 1830 and 1870.

Cool Springs' anniversary weekend included a Homecoming event on Saturday evening celebrating the sesquicentennial history and impact of the church. The Sunday service, filled to overflowing, featured special music by many groups from the church, including a youth choir and a video montage of the church's legacy.

Neil Wheeler, Waypoint's Director of Leader Care, delivered the morning message. The meal following the Sunday services would have been impressive in any era of the church's 25 decades of potluck fellowship meals.

Waypoint is always proud of the new churches you help us to launch each year in our region, now up to 162 and counting. But we stand on the shoulders of faithful churches like Cool Springs that are still impacting their communities after decades, even centuries, of service to Christ.





WAYPOINT ADDS NEW REGIONAL CATALYST

At their most recent quarterly meeting, the Waypoint Board of Directors unanimously approved the addition of Mark Magee to join the Waypoint staff as a Regional Catalyst to the DelMarVa Region (Delaware, Maryland, and Virginia).



Until January, Mark served for 32 years at The Crossing Church (formerly Lewes Church of Christ) in Milton, DE. During his tenure, the church grew and relocated to a new facility, now averaging more than 600 in two services each Sunday. A new capital campaign is in the works to further expand their facility.



For many years, Mark has provided leader care and coaching through meetups and retreats for many of the ministers in his area. Mark has also served churches all across the Waypoint region by leading


strategic planning retreats for church leadership teams.



A RESPITE RETREAT HOUSE OPENS IN VIRGINIA



BRCC recently encountered an unexpected opportunity to expand their facilities through the purchase of a beautiful 4-bedroom retreat house adjacent to the camp. This property, now known as The McCoy House, gives BRCC additional space needed to fulfill the camp's newly defined mission of providing rest and support for ministry leaders and their families. In addition, this space meets their need for extra staff housing during Summer camp programming.

The McCoy house is available for one or two-night respite and retreat stays for Christian leaders (and their families)

in the Waypoint region at a modest price. The house may also be rented for church staff or Elder retreats based on availability. An additional 5th bedroom is available on the camp property. No other facility of this kind exists in our region that is specifically focused on serving Christian Church and Churches of Christ ministries.
