Waypoint is thrilled to announce our next church planting project. Will and Hannah Kendrick (and their baby, Olive) will be planting in the fall of 2026

in the James Island area of Charleston, SC. Will grew up in Virginia where his family are members at longtime Waypoint Partner, Stella Christian Church, near Martinsville.

Will led the FCA ministry at the College of Charleston for the past 4 years. After completing the Passion for Planting assessment center in April and approval by the Waypoint Board of Directors in May, Will began a year-long church planting residency in June at a strong church in South Carolina.

With historic roots dating to the 1600s, the Charleston metro area is quickly approaching one million residents. The Census Reporter states that 32% of the population of the Charleston Metro Area has moved in since 2021. Charleston is now South Carolina's largest city.

This project will be Waypoint's second church plant in South Carolina and the 164th new church we've helped launch since our founding



THE Waypoint Podcast



Listen to episode 93 of the Waypoint Podcast when Church Planting wife, Holly Haulter, shared the story of their growing ministry to families with special needs children.

Since 1955, Waypoint has granted more than 200 modest, nointerest loans to partnering churches in the region to help them advance their ministry.

One of Waypoint's Church Plants, Catalyst Church in High Point, NC, was recently awarded a \$50,000 loan by our Board of Directors to help them build out another children's space of 1500 square feet in the commercial building where they meet.

Catalyst originally launched in 2009 and met in a high school and movie theater before occupying their current commercial space in 2020. Since then, Catalyst has experienced a growing impact with families who have special needs children. Many families can't go to church because of the special needs of their child.

The Waypoint Board of Directors recently approved their loan application to be paid back interest free over the next seven years. Catalyst hopes to open its space designed specifically for special needs children in the fall.

Over the years, other loans have been made by Waypoint to

Anthology will launch in Charles Town Middle School



The Anthology Launch Team



Anthology Church, led by Curtis and Abby Teel, is in the final stages of preparation for their launch in Charles Town, WV, on September 28th.

Anthology is Waypoint's second new church to be launched in the Mountain State. Charles Town is the fastest-growing city in West Virginia, having grown 29% since the 2020 census alone.

Anthology's Sunday services will be held at Charles Town Middle School near the heart of downtown. Anthology has also secured a commercial space they are calling the Anthology Hub on Washington Street, the town's main street, named after George Washington's youngest brother, Charles. The Hub will serve as their mid-week location for meetings, office space, youth group, and worship band rehearsals.

A series of Vision Nights and other events scheduled over the summer is growing the core team and creating a positive buzz about a new church coming to town in the fall.

Anthology was introduced to all the Christian Churches in the immediate region by serving as the summer-long mission at Cedar Creek Christian Camp, less than an hour away in Strasburg, VA.






Church Local Christian launched in Ashland, Virginia, in September 2023 in partnership with mothering church and longtime Waypoint partner, Fairmount Christian Church, along with other partners in the Richmond area. Local currently meets in the high school, but a leased commercial space in town is in the works. Local recently celebrated their 15th baptism.



Collective Church launched in January 2024 in Kinston NC, in partnership with Church Planters of Eastern North Carolina. This summer they celebrated their 25th baptism. Collective is the daughter church of recent church plant, Canvas Church in nearby Goldsboro. Canvas Church is, in turn, the daughter of Restore Church in Jacksonville, NC.







Kinetic Church in Columbia, SC, launched in 2019 just before COVID. They recently surpassed the 50 baptism mark. This was Waypoint's first effort in South Carolina in partnership with Nexus Church Planting. Waypoint welcomes its second new church to South Carolina, Salt Christian Church, in the fall of 2026.
