## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Mission Committee at Bridge Christian Church is to partner with Missionaries who make disciples globally. This is done through an overtly evangelical focus on church planting and church development. We recognize the importance of meeting basic human needs while carrying out the Great Commission. We are committed to working with the Missionaries, the Mission Organization, and with the help of Christ, to bring people to know and love Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

## **VISION (PRAY + CARE + SEND)**

We seek to establish relationships with our Missionaries, their families, their team/staff, and their churches. Our focus is to partner with the missionaries to help propel their ministry and not hinder it. Our strategy is to pray, care, and send. This includes prayer coverage, financial support, and sending teams. Teams will consist of individuals from our congregation to love and support missionaries on the field at least once a year. Our goal is to not only care ABOUT our missionaries but care FOR our missionaries!

## **FOCUS**

Because we cannot do everything, we have chosen areas of concentration that are a direct reflection of our vision and values as a church. There are many "good" things happening around the world, but these are the areas we feel called to focus on. These areas serve as a guide concerning "where" and "who" will be our Primary Mission Partners.

## **Guidelines for our Primary Mission Partners**

- 1. Being in line doctrinally with our "Family" of Churches.
- 2. The Ministry has an overtly evangelistic, church-planting, and/or disciple-making emphasis that is prayer-empowered, bible-focused, and gospel-centered
- 3. The geographic location fits our current need/plan: We desire to have a presence in many different parts of the world. We also have the desire to reach the unreached within these geographic areas.
- 4. Being a Couple/Family that our Bridge Church family can identify with and personally get to know and love.
- 5. The Ministry makes for a good International Harvest Campaign (IHC) in a 5–7-year rotation. (See explanation in funding guidelines)
- 6. The couple is supported by a quality Missions organization providing both ministry supervision and missionary care.
- 7. The Ministry can receive/support trips from Bridge well, including Youth trips and Interns.

## PARTNERSHIP COMMITMENTS

The Bridge Christian Church Mission Committee's goal is to have a strong partnership with our Primary Mission Partners and Missionaries. To help ensure this, we have developed a partnership agreement. This agreement serves to create a strong partnership for you, as well as the expectations you can expect to receive from us. We also outline the expectations that we have for our Partners. This is to ensure that we are supporting our partners as well as being good stewards of the resources God has entrusted us with.

## **FUNDING GUIDELINES**

## **Good Stewardship**

"From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and for the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked." **Luke 12:48** 

Bridge Mission Committee prayerfully desires to be good stewards of the resources God has entrusted to us.

**Primary Mission Partners -** We enter into a partnership with missionaries whose values align with the guidelines we have created for our Primary Mission Partners. They receive quarterly support in the amount of \$2,500.00 from Bridge, given to their mission organization for a total of 10,000.00 yearly. (Depending upon available funds) Mission Partners are also on a rotation for our annual International Harvest Campaign (IHC).

#### International Harvest Campaign (IHC):

The Bridge Mission Committee hosts an annual **BIG GIVE** each November. We call this *The International Harvest Campaign* (IHC). We choose a global mission partner from either our Mission Committee or our Outreach Committee (National Harvest Campaign) to highlight for the fall as a recipient. The mission point will choose a project for us to highlight during the campaign. Over the past decade, we have built an orphanage and a hospital in India, dug wells and planted churches in Ghana, translated the bible into languages that did not have access to the gospel, launched missionaries onto the field in Bosnia and New Zealand, raised pastors overseas, and much more.

**Associate Partners -** These are our missionaries! Individuals from Bridge who go on the mission field in other areas of focus. These individuals or families receive support as needed, along with other benefits such as care, trips, and prayer.

In the first quarter of each year, our Committee will conduct an annual assessment review based on the partnership agreement and assessments with each mission partner, organization, and missionary we support. We cannot in good faith continue to support a ministry without knowing how the funds are being used.

## BRIDGE CHRISTIAN CHURCH COMMITMENT

In addition to the financial commitment above, Bridge desires to be a care-giving church. We want to display the love of Jesus through personally and proactively engaging with our Mission Partners and Missionaries. Developing a relationship through communication, education, and action is our top priority. We want to care for the individual missionaries and their families' physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being.

## **Prayer Support:**

- We commit to praying for you and your family. Our hope is for each of our missionaries
  to feel comfortable and loved enough to share how we can be covering them, their
  families, and their ministries in good times and through hard times in prayer.
- We hold monthly prayer times with our Mission Committee.
- We hold quarterly Global Impact Gathering (GIG) Meetings that also have a prayer focus for each of our Mission Partners and Missionaries. At our GIG Event, we engage our congregation in your ministry through that prayer time.

## **Care Support:**

- We want to be available to you. Please know you can reach out to one of us with your needs (physical, emotional, or spiritual), and we will be here to help, pray, and walk with you to the very best of our ability.
- We want to communicate effectively with you and your team. You may choose your desired way of communication. (email, text, WhatsApp, etc.)
- We will fulfill the financial obligations that we have committed to you for the full year. We
  will also consider any urgent and/or unexpected financial needs when they arise. We will
  also consider any ministry needs when/if they arise.
- We want to care for you when you are home on assignment. Please let us know if you
  are coming to the States, and more importantly, to Virginia (Bridge is in Fisherville, VA),
  so we can prepare for your visit.
- We have Care Teams in place for our Primary Mission Partners and Missionaries. Care
  Teams meet regularly to pray for you, your family, and your ministries. Care Teams
  desire to KNOW you on a deeper level. They want to know your favorite foods, your
  birthday, anniversaries, and more. This gives them a deeper understanding of who you
  are, so they can better serve and care for you.

## **Send Support:**

- We want to regularly visit you on the field, to understand your work, to know what is taking place in your ministry, and to discern how we can better partner with you. When it suits, we will either send a Leadership/CareTeam or a Work Team to your ministry to encourage, benefit, and help propel your ministry.
  - Care trip No plans needed. This is a time to reconnect with our minisionaries and give them the
    opportunity to talk through the good and hard parts of ministry, family, and leadership. If ever
    needed, we can send additional support like training, counseling, debriefing, etc.
  - Work trip Unless you need new and fresh ideas, please do not just create things for us to do, we
    want to come help and support what you are already doing to take some of the burden from you.

## MISSION PARTNER COMMITMENT

As we work towards a closer relationship with our Primary Mission Partners, we ask that you commit to the following:

- We desire regular communication. Each missionary is expected to correspond with Bridge in some way. This can be through email, newsletters, phone, or in person. The purpose is to keep the church updated on how and what you are doing and how we can pray and encourage you specifically.
- We want to know of any changes relating to you or your ministry: any change in location, address, assignment, family, mission agency, and/or status should be communicated immediately to the Mission Minister at Bridge.
- We want to visit you yearly, to care for you while we work alongside our partners. We want you and your team to choose the dates and purpose of these trips.
- We want to be good stewards of the resources that we have been entrusted with.
   Therefore, we request that you provide us with the following information during the first quarter of each year.
  - Vision statement and strategy
  - o Explain how your mission aligns with Bridge Mission Committee's focus points
    - Overtly Evangelical
    - Church Planting
    - Disciple-making
    - Prayer empowered
    - Bible-focused
    - Gospel-centered
  - Goals
    - Results from the previous year
    - List goals for the coming year
  - Detailed financial reports
    - Income and expenses
    - Annual budget for the coming year
- Primary Partners will be evaluated and reviewed annually. The *exception* to this would be an immediate review when any of the following occurs:
  - There is a significant change in the ministry
  - There is a change in your Sending Agency
  - There is a deviation from Bridge's doctrinal beliefs
  - There is a failure to maintain consistent communication
  - There is a demonstrated inadequate accountability issue with the agreed commitments between Bridge and you
  - There is a legitimate integrity concern raised about your ministry
  - There is the inability to schedule trips or meetings, resulting in us not seeing you in that calendar year
