CHURCH PLANT EASTER PASSES 18,000!



EASTER ATTENDANCE SINCE REGATHERING

We are very pleased to report the combined Easter attendance at Waypoint church plants, launched since 1990, was a record: 18,044.

This total number of people eclipsed our previous record (16,240) by more than 1,700 set in 2019 just before the COVID pandemic. This total also represents a collective increase of more than 3,000 from last year's 2023 Easter!

More than half of our church plants individually surpassed their 2019 pre-pandemic Easter attendance. The Church at large has an exciting opportunity to reach a new generation hungry for hope in a time when our culture offers little.

ART OF THE SERMON EVENTS EQUIP AND RE-INSPIRE LEADERS

Waypoint hosted five Art of the Sermon events in five states this Spring. More than 200 leaders from around the region came to sharpen their communication skills and left encouraged and re-commissioned to boldly and effectively preach the Word of God to their churches and communities.

Leaders were taught and inspired by well-respected, nationally known preachers Bob Russell, Dave Stone, Brian Jones, and David Vaughan. Registrants included a wide spectrum of ages - high schoolers, college students, and several seasoned preachers in their 70s still wanting to improve their preaching acumen.

One feature of our annual preaching events is becoming a favorite element for many of the participants. A commissioning prayer closes the event where all the attendees gather like an athletic team for their half-time huddle to hear a charge from their leader before re-entering the field with energy and passion.

CHURCH PLANT ENTERS PERMANENT FACILITY

The birth of a new church and the day the first Elders are installed are two exciting days in the timeline for establishing a healthy church. Another equally important day is when they enter their permanent facility after years of being a portable church. With no more set up and tear down every week, all their equipment now has a home.

Restore Christian Church launched in March of 2017 in Jacksonville, NC, the home of Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune. The church plant was a collaboration with the primary partner, Church Planters of Eastern NC, Waypoint, and other supporting churches around the region.

Restore, led by church planter, Roger Burns, has worshiped in multiple venues including the downtown conference center and a local elementary school. In the Spring of 2022 Restore purchased a 100-year-old downtown 9,000 square foot brick building. The vacant facility, originally a department store, served a variety of uses over time including a homeless shelter and soup kitchen.

Their beautiful new building was financed by our friends at Christian Financial Resources. The auditorium seats 175 for worship along with 4 rooms for children's programming.

Their new space is already reaping major dividends: Restore was averaging about 130 before entering their new space. They welcomed 376 in worship for Easter Sunday compared to 170 last year when they were still in the conference center. They are now seeing more than 300 per week in two services. More importantly, since November Restore has also celebrated 18 baptisms!

We are thrilled with the record attendance on Easter at the new churches you've helped us to plant. We are even more pleased to celebrate more than 50 people baptized on Easter at our new churches. Our church planters are reporting even more people meeting with them since then to talk about and finalize new faith decisions.



DONATED PROPERTY TO SEED MULTIPLE DISCIPLE-MAKING CHURCHES



In the late 1970s and early 1980s, Waypoint experienced a church-planting era where we helped several churches around the region raise a building with construction crews who were called via our newsletter. Teams from around the region arrived to construct a new church building in as little as two weeks. The new church would celebrate its public launch within a few weeks of completion.

The Botetourt Church of Christ, near Roanoke, VA, later named the Valley Christian Church, was one of those churches. Waypoint continued to support the new church and its leaders for many years. When the church finally closed its doors for the final time in 2021 they left the property under the care of the Elders of Waypoint partner, Living Water Christian Church in nearby Salem. The father-son combo of Paul and Tim Hatfield, long-time friends of Waypoint, are Elders and Pastors at Living Water.



After the building was sold, the Living Water Elders decided to seed multiple new churches as a living legacy of the Valley Church. They recently donated the proceeds from the property's sale to Waypoint. Their primary value for the new churches is for the ministry focus to be driven by a disciple-making ethos led by leaders with a proven track record for making disciples who make disciples.




