

## Sermon-Based Small Group Questions Generator

### Instructions:

### SECTION 1: Opening Icebreaker Questions (6 total)

  - Keep questions **clear, personal, and practical**.

### SECTION 3: Final Challenge Questions (5 total)

- These should be **action-oriented** and encourage participants to apply the message **in a concrete, personal way** this week.
  - Think: real-life steps, changes in behavior, spiritual practices, or relational commitments.
-

Make the questions sound **natural** — not too formal or too theological — while still going **deep**.
