## CHURCH PLANT RETRO-FITS FORMER EQUESTRIAN FACILITY



Waypoint church plant, LifePointe Christian Church, launched in 2006 in an elementary school in Toano, Virginia, a northern suburb of Williamsburg. After outgrowing the elementary school they moved to a high school cafeteria across the street where they have worshiped since 2009.

Continued growth led them to purchase a 10-acre former equestrian events facility three miles west that included a 19,000 square foot dirt-floored riding ring, an eight-stall stable, and a historic 110 year-old three-story farmhouse needing complete restoration.


After two years to complete extensive zoning, site work, and construction, LifePointe finally opened her doors to the public in November. Their new facility includes a 330-seat worship space, an expansive lobby and cafe, a wing for children and youth programming, and a fully renovated farmhouse to be used for offices and meeting space.

LifePointe's new logo and branding capitalized on the weather vanes around the property. Kudos to Lead Minister Phil Murdock and the rest of the leaders at LifePointe for the great work to transform this property immediately positioned for community impact!

NC. Here is the description of the opening day from church planter, Kevin McNeil:

Finally at 10:00 AM our service would start with 163 people who all heard the gospel message of Luke 15 preached that morning with three people coming forward to commit their life to Jesus after the service. # 21IN'21 CAMPAIGN CONCLUDES WITH BIG GIVEAWAYS




Hosting the International Conference on Missions afforded Waypoint the special opportunity to launch an initiative to raise funds from churches around the region to facilitate the launch of 21 new churches around the globe. Five planting organizations were chosen to receive the funds that were pledged by dozens of churches over the past 3 years.

We are proud to see five new churches being launched in the former Soviet state of Moldova, in the Muslim territory of North Ghana, in the Buddhist region

of Nepal, and in the burgeoning city of Queretaro, Mexico. The 21st church is being launched to reach the Filipino community in and around Raleigh, North Carolina.

More than \$400,000 have been pledged toward this God-sized initiative for global impact. Ceremonial checks were awarded to each organization during each main session during ICOM to feature their ministry. Please pray for these 21 churches and their pastors as they launch!

# NEW CHURCH TO LAUNCH IN TIDEWATER AREA OF VIRGINIA



Waypoint is excited to announce plans for a new project, Journey Church, to be planted in Virginia Beach. Plans are being made for a Spring launch timeline. The most recent project for Waypoint in the Tidewater area was Celebration Church in nearby Suffolk in the Spring of 2002, twenty years ago.

Church planter, James Davis, is a 2005 graduate of Mid-Atlantic University and served on staff for seven years at another Waypoint plant in Virginia Beach, Forefront Christian Church, before planting The Rising, a new church in downtown Norfolk, Virginia in 2014. James, a Norfolk native, cut his teeth on ministry serving as a teenager at the “Teen Church” for what is now Waypoint Partner, Real Life Christian Church in Chesapeake.

James and his wife, Irene, have been married for 15 years and have two children, Amaya (9) and Aiden (5). Irene is a successful entrepreneur, with her own graphic design and photography companies. James and Irene successfully completed Waypoint’s Church Planter assessment in August.

James is now completing the weekly tasks associated with our Church Planting Project Management and a Residency Cohort with our ministry partner, Passion For Planting. Initial efforts for launch team recruitment and development along with fund-raising appeals are netting positive returns. Waypoint will provide further support with an oversight team and monthly ministry coaching.


