WAYPOINT PARTNERS WITH UPCOMING NC CHURCH PLANT



Meet the Pileggis. Waypoint is pleased to partner with Collective Church, a new project launching this coming January in Kinston, North Carolina. Our friends, the Church Planters of Eastern NC, are serving as the project's managing partner.

Cory and Meg Pileggi and their family are recruiting and developing a strong launch team in Kinston. Cory served as the Operations Pastor and church planter in residence for two years at another recent plant, Canvas Christian Church, in Goldsboro, about 30 miles West.





The Pileggis have four kids and have been foster parents to 12 more, with two becoming permanent members of their family. Cory is completing his Masters degree in Theology from Liberty University.

Cory was part of last year's distance church-planting residency cohort with our ministry partner, Passion for Planting. Their recent preview services in the local movie theater have seen over 70 attending and included two baptisms—Cory's parents!



DONATED PROPERTY BECOMES WAYPOINT CHURCH PLANT #159



In June 2021 the remaining members of Northside Christian Church, about 25 of them, voted to entrust their building and property in North Durham, NC to Waypoint with a vision to see a new work started as a legacy to their 40 years of ministry in that community.



After completing an assessment in December 2021, Waypoint hired Greg and Katie Coverdale as our church-planting couple. Their family moved to Durham in July 2022 from coastal New Bern, NC to prepare to launch this fall. Greg served as the Associate Minister for 12 years at Two Rivers Church, another successful church plant in NC.



Greg was part of last year's Church-planting residency cohort with our ministry partner, Passion for Planting. Other NC partners in this project include Church Planters of Eastern NC, Compass Christian (Fuquay-Varina), Two Rivers Church and Broad Creek Christian (New Bern), Jefferson Christian (Rural Hall), Macedonia Christian (Williamson), Journey Christian (Washington), and Plymouth Church of Christ, along with these partners in Virginia: Stella Christian (Patrick Springs), Northampton Christian (Hampton), and Pleasant Hill Christian (Gasburg).



After extensive work to update the property, Renew Christian Church opened on September 10th with 139 people attending. Several former members of Northside Church were in attendance. Since launch, attendance has reached 80+ with first-time visitors each week.

FAIRMOUNT CHURCH "DAUGHTERS" A CHURCH IN ASHLAND, VA

Long-time partner, Fairmount Christian Church in Mechanicsville, VA, began setting aside funds over 4 years ago with a vision to see a daughter church launched in Ashland, a growing town about 20 miles North of their campus.

After a search for the right church-planting candidates, Bruce and Bethany Humphrey completed a church-planting assessment in January 2022. The Humphreys had been part of another church plant near Tampa, FL. The Humphreys moved from Florida to Ashland last July to begin preparations to establish what would be called, Local Christian Church.

Fairmount, as the mothering church, set Bruce up as their church planter in residence. They also provided three members of the project's Oversight Team. Many volunteers



from Fairmount helped staff the slate of prelaunch outreach events in Ashland to raise awareness for their upcoming launch.

On their 120th anniversary celebration three weeks prior to Local's opening day, Fairmount commissioned the Local launch team and ordained Jacob Ward, Local's Next Gen Pastor, into the ministry.

Local's opening day on September 17th in Ashland's Patrick Henry High School saw 120 in attendance. Their inaugural service included the baptism of Jamie, who serves on Local's launch team. Local is now seeing about 70 each Sunday with visitors returning each week.

Other partners in Virginia collaborating in this project include Journey and Kindred Christian (Midlothian), Area10 Church (Richmond), Compass Christian and Gethsemane Church of Christ (Mechanicsville), Chester Christian, Rappahannock Church of Christ (Warsaw), as well as two from Florida: Central Christian (St. Petersburg) and Sebastian Christian.



FIRST ELDERS INSTALLED AT CHURCH PLANT IN BOONE, NC



Launch day is a seminal moment in the life of our new churches. Another day of equal importance is the installation of the church's first set of Elders. This is the day a church becomes fully independent, overseen exclusively by local leaders. Typically this process takes about 4-5 years for a new church to be fully "established."

Mountainside Church, a five-year-old Waypoint plant in Boone, NC, recently installed three leaders to serve as their first class of Elders. They had completed a season of training and orientation. On the day of their installation, the church body was invited to come forward to lay hands on their pastor-shepherds during the commissioning prayer.



FORMER METHODIST CHURCH PARTNERS WITH WAYPOINT



Cecil's Chapel was organized as a Methodist Church in 1885 in Hiwassee, Virginia in the Shenandoah Valley near Pulaski. This Spring they formally disaffiliated with the Meth-United odist denomination over doctrinal differences. More

than 6000 churches have disaffiliated nationwide. Half of them have joined the newly-formed more conservative Global Methodist Church. The remaining have become independent congregations like Cecil's Chapel.

A family within the Chapel's congregation are former members of Waypoint partner, Community Christian Church, in nearby Dublin, VA. They contacted Waypoint for assistance filling their pulpit while they searched for and hired their new minister, the first time they have hired their own preacher in over 135 years.

As a newly independent church, the Chapel needed a family of churches to belong to, providing connection and support, while still retaining their newly independent status. We are very pleased they have chosen to partner with Waypoint.

The earliest days of the Methodist church in America saw another group of churches in Virginia disaffiliate from the Methodist Church in 1792. Led by James O'Kelly, they first called themselves "Republican Methodists" referring to their ability to vote for themselves about local decisions.

Two years later this group agreed their churches should take on the name of Christian Churches to the exclusion of any other sectarian names. The first so-named "Christian Church" in America was Lebanon Christian Church in Spring Grove across the James River from Williamsburg.
