EVANGELISM STILL STRONG DURING YEAR OF PANDEMIC

Dozens of studies have confirmed that the average new church gains most of its new members, as much as 80%, from people not attending any worshipping body, while churches over 10 years of age gain 80% of their new members by transfers from other congregations.

The ministry of starting new churches is by far the best way to reach new people for Christ in America! We are very happy to report that in spite of all the well-documented challenges the pandemic placed on our new churches, their focus on Evangelism never wavered.

This past year, the new churches you have helped us start celebrated 336 more immersions, nearly one per day—not only in baptistries, but in swimming pools, rivers, lakes, the ocean, hot tubs, feeding troughs and even in the bed of pickup trucks!

Thank you again for partnering with Waypoint to plant more churches, more often, to reach even more people for Christ! Jesus promised that He would build his church, and the very gates of Hell would not overpower it.

NEW FACILITIES FOR CHURCH



COLLECTIVE CHURCH FREDERICK, MD

Collective Church launched in September 2017 in Frederick, MD, an outer suburb of Washington, DC. Church planter Michael Bartlett and his team lead Collective.

They were meeting in the West Frederick Middle School before the pandemic.

Their new space is 11,000+ square feet and will seat up to 300 in each service once they receive their final occupancy permit from the city.



THE POINT - NORTH RALEIGH, NC

The Point - North Raleigh launched in March, 2016. The Point Church - North Raleigh is led by Justin Gillespie and his team.

They met in a local school for just three weeks when Covid shut them down on their launch Sunday.

They were forced to worship online only at first, then met for afternoon services in another church. Their beautiful new space holds up to 500 seats.



H PLANTS DURING PANDEMIC

KINETIC CHURCH COLUMBIA, SC

Kinetic Church launched in January 2019 in the capitol city of Columbia, SC. Church planter Kevin Huston and his team of volunteers lead Kinetic.

They were worshipping weekly in the auditorium of the local Community College when the pandemic forced them online only.

Thankfully, a new space became available with 6,000 square feet, seating up to 100.



MOUNTAINSIDE COMMUNITY CHURCH, BOONE, NC

Mountainside Community Church launched in Boone, NC in 2018. Mountainside is led by church planter Shannon McCreedy and his team.

They met in the local theater complex before moving to a local bar for their worship space.

The pandemic forced them to move to a facility with more space for distancing. They now meet weekly in the 100-year-old Apple Barn, a beautiful wedding venue just outside of town.





JOIN THE ICOM 21 IN '21 CAMPAIGN

The International Conference on Missions (ICOM) returns to our region in November in Richmond, Virginia. You're invited!



As host for the conference, Waypoint has launched a collaborative initiative to see 21 new churches planted globally through five trusted missions organizations. Churches and partners from around the Waypoint region are invited to join this campaign to raise \$500,000 toward this God-sized project.



One of the organizations planting at least five of these 21 churches around the globe is disciplemakers.org. God has given them the vision of planting 2,500 new churches by the end of 2025. To date, 1,300 churches have been planted, with more than 30,000 baptisms in the last 20 years.

Disciplemakers train local preachers in Honduras, Guatemala, Kenya, Korea, Myanmar and Nepal. They feature a program for churches and individuals to adopt an evangelist in one of these countries.



The funds associated with the 21in'21 campaign will be directed to train Christian evangelists in Nepal. 90% of Nepal's population of 30 million is Hindi or Buddhist.
