Mr. Roy Li studied Clarinet at the Adelaide Elder Conservatorium with the Principle of ASO: Dean Newcomb before 2016, then moved to Sydney to further his study at the Sydney Conservatorium with Susan Newsome and Frank Celata, performed in master class with professor Janet Hilton, Andrew Marriner and Sabine Meyer.

Mr. Li has performed extensively in Australia and overseas as a soloist and an orchestral clarinettist, including with the Conservatorium Wind Symphony and Symphony Orchestra, Modern Music Ensemble, the Modest Orchestra, Lismore Conservatorium Orchestra; Sinfonia Australia. He has held Principal Clarinet positions in the Modern Music Ensemble and toured to World Music Festival in 2019.



In addition to his work as a performer, Mr. Li has over 10 years of extensive teaching experience. This includes Clarinet and Saxophone pedagogy, Chamber ensemble and concert band conducting, orchestral and chamber music mentoring. He has taught at venues including the Sydney Conservatorium of Music, the Lismore Conservatorium of Music, Caringbah High School, Gordon West PS, Sydney Catholic School etc., In 2020, Mr. Li established Delicato Music Academy where his primary teaching take place at, he is also the band director in Sydney Catholic Schools System and a guest conductor at Sunshine Phil Youth Orchestra.
